














Auxiliary News...

Greetings to all members of the Ontario American Legion Post 112 Family.

Our move is continuing along as we are dotting our I's and crossing our T's and things are starting to come together. We are still in the sample taking stages at our present location. They are checking for hazard materials such as lead paint, asbestos in floor tiles, popcorn ceilings and so forth.

I know some of you have noticed the paint markings in the parking lot, this the result that in the past there was a Dry Cleaners not far from the Post and was the practice in the day many of the cleaning fluids and solvents were simply dumped on the ground, hence a possible groundwater contamination. So to date the City/County are having to test soil samples so that they know how to best apply a proper solution. (These test come at no cost to our Post and are required by the City and County)
