Wesley UMC Outreach Committee Minutes

Thursday, September 11, 2025 – 11:00 a.m. – via ZOOM

Members present: Jan Kurtz, Janet Martin, Michelle Hudgins, Linda Yost, Brenda Kennedy, Connie Wiegel

Jan opened the meeting at 11a.m. It has been 24 years since the tragedies of 9/11. Some of our committee saw American flags being displayed on tractors and other places. One man was running with an American flag near a local school. 9/11 needs to be taught in our school history curriculum.

Discussed the possibility of obtaining more Committee members. Suggested various folks to ask.

Treasurer's Report

Linda reported that as of Sept. 11, 2025, the current total in the Outreach checking account was 1,999.70. There is a monthly debit withdrawal of \$43 to Compassion Child. She had paid two quarterly payments to NESAP and Westminster Rescue Mission in August. Linda asked the protocol for reimbursing herself from the Outreach account for the backpacks. It was agreed that she could write a check made payable to herself and then sign the check as well. Should make a note in the memo section that it is reimbursement for backpacks.

Last month Jan asked if we used funds from the Harrell Camping Ministry for Helping Up Missions camp. Had not as of that meeting. (After meeting, Linda spoke with Dave. They agreed that it was too late in the year to send camp donation, but would keep it in mind for 2026.)

Jan asked how much money we pay out each year. \$400 Westminster; \$500 NESAP; \$135 back packs; 560 Compassion Child; postage for Christmas Child boxes; college students (\$25.00 per college student twice a year) Decided our giving parameters will be to children and grandchildren of church members. Linda will send a greeting card and also a Christian bookmark or Bible verse along with the gift card. Will place a request for names now in the Wesley Announcements and the Journal. Will send out in late October/early November and also in February.

Meals

Westminster Rescue Mission meal. Will see how much soup is left over from the Bazaar and can donate it to the Mission. Janet will talk to the person in charge of meals and see how many are in residence.

Night By Night Shelter

Janet has not been receiving very much for the shelter. She is wondering if we should drop it at this point. She will check to see what their needs are at this time.

Wesley Pantry

Linda will call Stephanie Halley to ask about whether the Westminster Rescue Mission could help stock our pantry. Janet said that due to regulations, the Mission cannot stock pantries that are outside and unsupervised.

New Business

- Cookie walk Will be on cantata Sunday. Date to be determined.
- January soup sale Date to be determined.
- Jan attends the Caring Parish meeting every month. Spoke about different things being collected parish-wide. Two of those items are diapers for the Diaper Bank and pet food for those unable to provide food for their pets.
- If the Night-by-Night Shelter needs blankets, it can be advertised in the Grow Guide to go out to the whole parish.
- NESAP Wesley canned goods collection Nov. 2 23, 2025. Janet will need help loading these goods into her car on the 23^{rd} , and also decorating the Sanctuary for Christmas that day.

- Christmas Bazaar –Bazaar date is Saturday, November 1, 2025. Janet is worried that repeat vendors aren't stepping up this year. There are not any new ones. Wesley United Methodist Church Administrative Council Meeting September 24, 2025 – 7:00 p.m. via ZOOM

Jan Kurtz opened the meeting at 7:05 pm and Pastor Melissa offered up a prayer.

Committee Reports

Pastor Melissa Rudolph

Reported on the joint parish meeting of Pulse and SPRC which came up with recommendations and guidelines for clergy compensation for the coming year. Hoped that any increases could be covered by the surplus in the parish treasury, which has been the case over the last few years, however, in doing so at this point, those funds would be exhausted in 2026. Zach, the parish treasurer, has put together some different models as to how the cost-of-living adjustments will affect the pay-in for each congregation. Dave Hudgins will be having a meeting with Zach this week to discuss this. There were multiple models that showed the various possibilities for how to we could do the cost-of-living adjustments that go into the clergy salaries. Zach gave us some that involved utilizing the entirety of the funds, some half of the funds, and one that adjusts the percentage rates for all 8 of the churches in the parish. He had sent that out to all the finance chairs. Dave believes the increase for Wesley will be approximately \$1500 more per year. The discussion at the meeting will determine which model they all would be comfortable with. This increase is to cover cost-of-living increases for Pastor Melissa, Pastor John and Pastor Jerry. Now have Malory Mcfeeney as new parish administrator. She will join on Sept. 29th. She had been in training and then her mother suddenly passed away from a stroke. As a good will gesture, she was given a week of bereavement pay due to her loss. Because of this later start date, she won't be very helpful getting our Charge Conference forms together. Melissa is working with all the churches to get things submitted by October 1st. Need to get a new code for Wesley UMC for access to some of the forms. Our Church Conference is Oct. 18th at 1 pm at Towson UMC. Melissa is seeking clarity as to how this is going to operate. Our hub has historically done this as one, so she needs more information on the structure of the Church Conference. We will meet our new Reservoir District Superintendent, Eliezer Valentín-Castañón. All church members are invited to attend. If you would like to carpool to Towson UMC, please contact Jan Kurtz.

Looking forward to the joint World Communion Sunday service on October 5th at 10:00 a.m. at
Grace UMC. Hoping that the pastor in Malawi can join in live via ZOOM. After the service there
will be some discussion on having a joint Live Nativity during the Christmas season and some
other parish initiatives. Jan informed the Council that Wesley and St. John's will have a combined
choir for the Christmas cantata.

Staff Parish Relations Committee - August meeting: Brenda Hess, Chairperson

- Custodian Job Description and job checklist have been updated. Was considering bringing in a cleaning crew to help. Trustees said not at this time.
- Church Organist job description has been updated and approved by this committee.
- Ann Chilson has agreed to fill in for Jeff if he needs a Sunday off and she will perform at no cost to the church. Gift to Wesley.
- Dave Hudgins and I will be attending the Pulse and SPRC meeting on September 15th 2025 at Greenmount Church, hosted by Pastor Melissa Rudolph.
- There will be no SPRC meeting in September or October.
- Church staff evaluations will be conducted in October.
- October is Pastor Appreciation Month- Brenda will contact Cherie, our Administrative Assistant and have her add a note in the October Wesley Announcements and Journal to remind the congregation.
- Our next SPRC meeting will be held on November 11^{th.} We will be discussing our Christmas yearend giving for staff, pastors and special missions.

Trustees: Linda Yost, member

- Duct work under the Sanctuary was dripping condensation during the humid summer. A young man, Mr. Stocksdale from Tm Kyle Electric who had gone to church here, wrapped the ducts. Will keep an eye on whether or not we need to wrap the remaining ductwork.
- Had discussed finding someone to do a service plan for all our heat pump units, boilers, and mini splits. A rep from Tim Kyle Electric did a walk through. Estimate \$2151 per year for three oil burners (includes the parsonage), the kitchen A/C, classroom mini-splits, two heat pumps under the Sanctuary which includes routine maintenance, cleaning, nozzle, filter and strainer on oil burners (cleaning and replacement), inspection and identifying of potential problems, performance checks, Will be obtaining additional estimates.
- Rent for the parsonage is now \$800 per month.
- The Fellowship Hall new flooring has been buckling up. Wondering if the problem was the glue they used. Carpet Workshop fixed most of the problem and has ordered additional supplies if more repair is needed. They are standing by their work. Will repair until it is satisfactory. Will keep an eye on it.
- Dean will order 12 new 8-foot tables for the Fellowship Hall. They are 30 inches wide. Can use some of the heavier tables in the classrooms. Those not needed immediately are being stored in the back storage area. All Trustees present were in favor of purchasing 12 new tables.
- Sanctuary front doors have been painted. Weeds in the garden beds have been pulled.
- Articles of Incorporation paperwork for the cemetery have been filed with the IRS. Will take anywhere from 6 weeks to 6 months for response.
- Next meeting will be Wednesday, October 1, 2025, 7:00 p.m. via ZOOM.

Finance Committee: Dave Hudgins, Church Treasurer - Reports available upon request.

- Balance sheet total operating fund cash is at a healthy balance.
- Finance met in August and will again meet in October. Discussed an interest-bearing fund for a small portion of our extra cash.
- Profit and Loss Total income: Main giving is down 7.6% as of August. Employee Credit Retention (ERC) refund has helped with our income. This will be the last year for this refund.
- Budget for 2026 will probably lower our expectation of income.
- Electric cost is higher than budgeted.
- Wesley Improvement Project (WIP): Includes Fellowship Hall improvements and the 2024 A/C system for Sanctuary. Expenses were higher than planned. Trustees needs to be aware that there are no WIP funds remaining for future projects at this time.
- NCCP increase 2.5%. is in discussion among the parish churches.
- He will be asking church chairpersons for budget input in October. Wants to have the 2026 budget to present at Ad Council in November.
- Linda reported that Dawn's computer needed a new motherboard, which was replaced by a Dell tech. Computer is still under warranty so no cost. Infopathways was involved also, so there may be some fee forthcoming for their guidance.
