Committee Reports

Pastor Melissa Rudolph – via email

- 1) We are planning for Wesley to have Christmas Eve services at 4 and 11.
- 2) Nominations— if there is anyone who would like to roll off of a committee this year, let me know. We can fill the vacancy and approve it at the next meeting. Currently, Wesley is the only church in the parish that is not operating under the single board model. If there is interest in moving toward that model, we can have discussions in the New Year. But, since the committees are so well-organized and functional, I will leave that up to the board. We will be having regular meetings of our HUB/ Pulse team, so we do need two individuals to represent Wesley at those in the coming year. The schedule will be complete in January.
- 3) I am forming a parish wide team for our Malawi partnership, so I welcome participation.
- 4) Today I got word that our parish will receive a grant of \$2250 from the Conference for a special initiative for young adult ministry. This is something I applied for last year and hadn't heard anything about, so I'm very excited that we are a recipient.

Jan is not sure how to go about nominations. Wesley doesn't have a large pool of people to pull from. We have to decide how to go about this. The pastor is supposed to chair this committee. Janet suggested that each committee meet and the Chair ask if the members would be willing to serve another year. We all need clarification on the One Board model. Need to see how other churches in the NCCP operate on this model. Suggested someone attend one of their meetings. Will table this discussion for now.

Staff Parish Relations Committee

- report for 11/11/2025
- 5 members in attendance
- (2) Staff members' evaluations completed.
- Jeff Horner requested to have one Sunday a month off. Anne Chillson will fill in for Jeff Horner and play organ or piano on the 4th Sunday of each month starting on January 25th.
- Dave Hudgins discussed salary adjustments for church staff.
- Wesley Christmas Giving letters have been sent out to congregation.
- Our next SPRC mtg will meet next January 14th 2026 via Zoom connection.

Trustees: Linda Yost, member

- Repairs have been completed by Aero on the Education Wing boiler. Need to set up a service plan early in 2026 for all our units as described below.
- Had discussed finding someone to do a service plan for all our heat pump units, boilers, and mini splits. A rep from Tim Kyle Electric did a walk through. Estimate \$2151 per year for three oil burners (includes the parsonage), the kitchen A/C, classroom mini-splits, two heat pumps under the Sanctuary which includes routine maintenance, cleaning, nozzle, filter and strainer on oil burners (cleaning and replacement), inspection and identifying of potential problems, performance checks, Will be obtaining additional estimates.
- The Fellowship Hall new flooring has been buckling up. Carpet Workshop fixed most of the problem and has ordered additional supplies if more repair is needed. They are standing by their work. Will repair until it is satisfactory. Will keep an eye on it.
- Articles of Incorporation paperwork for the cemetery has been filed with the IRS. Will take anywhere from 6 weeks to 6 months for response.
- Searching for new bids on mowing of the church and cemetery.
- May need to check if the Weavers will be shoveling the sidewalks and steps. The parking lot is taken care of by the Lippy family.
- Next meeting will be Wednesday, December 3, 2025 at 7 p.m. in person at the church.

Finance Committee: Dave Hudgins, Church Treasurer – Reports available upon request.

- Reviewed Balance Sheet.
- Reviewed yields for General Endowment Fund (RBC Account) and Cemetery Account (RBC).
- Discussed an interest-bearing fund for a small portion of our extra cash. Suggested putting some funds into either in another RBC account or a CD account.
- Ad Council members agreed to leave this decision up to Dave's discretion.
- Reviewed YTD v. Budget through October
- ERC refunds have helped us this year. There is one more pending which we may or may not receive.
- Reviewed General Funds receipts and expenses.
- Net Income is to the good, with the help of the ERC refunds.
- **Draft of 2026 Budget presented for review.**
- Parsonage rental will remain the same for 2026, May revisit Parsonage rental for 2027.
- NCCP salary increase will be approximately 2.5%.
- If Cemetery breaks off from Church, then mowing expenses will be divided.
- We are looking at a deficit in 2026. Hoping to have an increase in income. May need to shift funds as needed.

- May need to do a second fundraiser in addition to the Christmas Bazaar.
- Janet Martin moved to approve the budget as presented. Linda Hollman seconded the motion. All were in favor. Motion passed.
- Janet asked if our church could have our own Venmo account. Dave will check on that.

United Methodist Men's Group: Dave Hudgins, President

- UMM met in October and November with nice breakfast meetings.
- Provide supper to Westminster Rescue Mission in October.
- Made a \$200 donation to Westminster Rescue Mission for recovery bibles for their client.
- Made a \$150 donation to stock the Wesley Food Pantry. Greg and Connie Wiegel will take care of this.
- \$500 donated to VIP program on Carroll St. in Hampstead to help support Veterans housing needs. John Sies has the check. He and Greg Wiegel will make a presentation to be given in honor of Mike Sater for his work years ago in helping to set up this program.
- Supported the Bazaar by providing breakfast and will provide snacks for Fellowship in December.
- They will also handle the Shrove Tuesday Pancake Supper
- Had a nice turnout for the Christmas Bazaar and support in set up and clean up by Scouts. Disbursement checks to Church, Outreach, UWFaith and UMM will be given out in December. A bit smaller profit this year than last.
- Dave will reach out to Vicky for a breakdown of income.

- Had a Thanksgiving children's Sunday School gathering on Nov.15
- Christmas Pageant will be presented on Sun., Dec. 7th.
- Will have a Christmas children's Sunday School gathering on Dec. 21st.

- Linda sent out gift cards to the college students.
- Westminster Rescue Mission meal. Outreach will provide a number of side dishes for Thanksgiving.
- A number of parish churches will provide meals to WRM between Christmas and New Years.
- Wesley Pantry is being well-stocked.
- Janet will check to see the needs of the Night by Night Shelter at this time. Have 60 plus people.
- Cookie walk – Will be on Wesley cantata Sunday, Dec. 14th. Choir will be singing cantata with St. John's Choir. Will present cantata on Sunday Dec. 14th at Wesley, and on Sunday, Dec. 21st at St. John's.
- 47 boxes donated for Operation Christmas Child.
- Christmas caroling is tbd.
- Have 2 Christmas families – are collecting gifts for them.
