Wesley United Methodist Church Administrative Council Meeting April 23, 2025 – 7:00 p.m. via ZOOM

Members present: Jan Kurtz, Dave Hudgins, Linda Yost, Jonathan Yost, Brenda Kennedy, Michelle Hudgins, Connie Wiegel, Linda Hollman, Denny Rill, Jackie Otwell, Brenda Hess, Rev. John Rudolph

Jan Kurtz opened the meeting at 7:05 p.m.

Committee Reports

1. Staff Parish Relations Committee: Brenda Hess, Chair

- No meetings for February or April. Dean Brewer, Trustee Chair, brought to her attention that the church needed more deep cleaning. He is thinking about a cleaning service, maybe twice a year, to do more heavy cleaning that Calvin Lucy, our Custodian, can't get to. Calvin works about 6 -7 hours on Thursday, and sometimes a few hours on Saturday. Dusting of furniture, window cleaning, cobwebs, floor waxing, carpet cleaning need to be addressed. Could get a couple of estimates. Need to decide what needs to be done. Dave Hudgins stated that Trustees should take the lead on either having Calvin do this cleaning or an outside service. Could have Calvin price out the cost for him doing this deep cleaning, along with two other bids. This is being sent back to Trustees to discuss and arrange.
- Rev. Dr. Ann Laprade, our District Superintendent, is having a retirement celebration at Fallston UMC on Sunday, June 8, 2025.

2. Trustees: Linda Yost, member

- Trustees did not meet in April. Have had José and his company pull weeds and clean up the gardens.
 The Scouts will also do some additional garden weeding along with the playground in back and picking up sticks, etc. near the ramp in the near future. Dave Hudgins suggested they weed around the Memorial Prayer Garden.
- Tim Rill will be contacting Gary Wilmer to schedule a time to re-evaluate what needs to be done to the windowsill and framing around the front Sanctuary stained-glass window.
- Jan spoke with Gary and Vicky at church who are in the process of cutting off the bottom of the double wooden doors of the Fellowship Hall so that they can close over the new tile. They have one completed but will need help rehanging both doors as they are very heavy. Gary will contact Dean.
- There is a fan running in the Organ room when the organ is off. Dean will check on this.

3. Finance Committee: Dave Hudgins, Church Treasurer - Reports available upon request.

- Dave emailed charts of the church's income and expenses. Expenses are running higher than budgeted
 due to WIP upgrades. The electrical system for the HVAC has been worked on and issues have been
 corrected that previous electrical contractor caused. Regular budget income and expenses are about as
 expected.
- Next Finance meeting is planned for May

4. United Methodist Men's Group: Dave Hudgins, President

- Have met in March and April for breakfast at Dutch Corner Restaurant in Manchester.
- Near the end of March, the UMM provided supper for the Westminster Rescue Mission. Some of the men stayed and ate with the residents. During the next few months the UMM will discuss other mission opportunities.

5. Christian Education- Jackie Otwell, Chair

- Attendance remains stable at about 15 students each Sunday.
- She again thanked whoever purchased the whiteboard. She uses it every Sunday.
- The students gathered for a group lesson and Easter Egg Hunt on Palm Sunday.
- Our 4-6th Grade class painted rocks for the Wesley gardens and did some outreach by collecting cold weather clothing over the winter months. Because the Night-by-Night shelter is not taking winter clothing at this time, Jackie will store it in the Sunday School room until the fall. They also worked on a bulletin board in the hallway displaying the Beatitudes theme.
- The last day of Sunday School will be May 18, 2025. The teachers are planning to celebrate everyone's birthday during class that day.
- Jackie also would like the children to continue participating in the 5th Sunday worship services, as suggested by Janet Martin, Worship Chair. It went over very well the last two times. They would greet, take up the offering, and read the Scripture.
- She would like the Teachers to survey the parents for next year. There will be 6 students in 5th-7th grade. They will be in a transition to middle school. Need to decide what to offer them regarding Sunday School.
- Jackie and Linda will work together this summer as Wesley is going to host a free, parish-wide camp at Wesley for approximately 30 children. The theme is "The Best Christmas Party Ever." Like a Christmas in July theme. It will be held July 14-17, Monday-Thursday from 9 a.m. until 12 noon. It will be structured in a similar way as VBS but with a somewhat different emphasis. There are youth helpers available who are vetted and work throughout the summer. We have some of our ladies who have worked in the past at Wesley, but will need more.
- Pastor John added more information: all the camps that the parish will hold this summer will be
 Christmas Every Day -themed. Will have many volunteers, parish-wide, and everyone is encouraged to
 volunteer for any of the camps throughout the summer, even if only for one morning. Had about 150
 volunteers last summer. Gives everyone an opportunity to serve in a really important way because of
 working with children and it is a lot of fun. Camps are: Sports, Agriscience, Camp Harmison, Best
 Christmas Party Ever, STEAM. Sunday, May 18th Leader's Meeting and Volunteer's Meeting.
- July preaching series will also be Christmas.

6. Outreach- Jan Kurtz, Chairperson

- Meeting was held April 9, 2025 4:00 p.m. (trying out a new time) via ZOOM
- Meals No one is receiving meals at this time.
- Easter Baskets Our congregation filled 23 Easter buckets and Linda and Jonathan delivered them to Shepherd Staff.

Janet reported that there is nothing new. Still collecting items. Linda asked if we are still collecting blankets. Janet said she will check.

- **Dove House -** Still collecting until Easter Sunday.
- Wesley Pantry Need is great. Jan asked Jackie if the Sunday School children could bring in some canned goods and put them in the Pantry. Suggested that donations could be for the month of May.
- New Business Pie, Crisps and Cobblers

Will begin advertising and providing an order form on Easter Sunday. Members will make various pies. **Next meeting – TBD (perhaps in July)**
