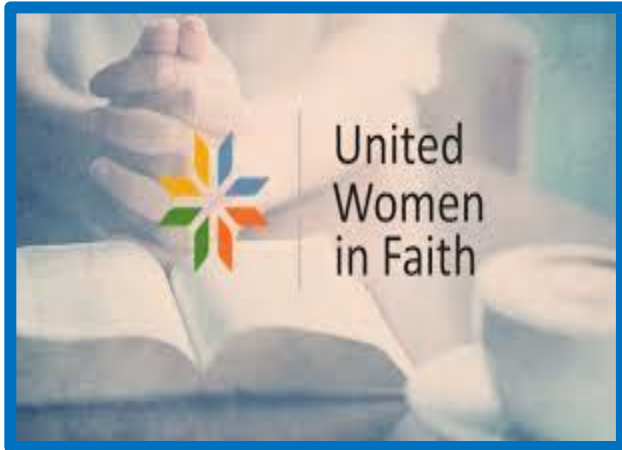

Wesley United Methodist Church Administrative Council Meeting January 28, 2026 – 7:00 p.m. via ZOOM

Jan Kurtz opened the meeting at 7:06 pm.

Committee Reports

Pastor Melissa Rudolph

- Wesley will host Ash Wednesday Service at 7 p.m. for the parish.
- During Lent, Pastor Melissa will lead a 12-noon prayer service at St. John's, followed by a soup lunch.
- She has been working with all the parish SPRC's to put forth her goals for the coming year. The following are the goals she will work on:
 - She is assembling a parish-wide team of at least six persons as a Malawi partnership, who can oversee the mission and be additional communicators with the leaders in Malawi, so she welcomes participation. There will be a trip to Malawi in mid-August for any of the team who wish to go, to see the progress they have made since their last trip.

- This year she will be participating in the Financial Leadership Academy through the Mid Atlantic Foundation additional learning around financial stewardship and leadership and guidance. She is excited to be part of this cohort.
- On February 10th at Emory, Frank Robert from Mid Atlantic will give a presentation on financial best practices and planned giving, legacy giving for the churches and a dinner will be provided.
- Closer to spring, Pastor Melissa will begin having small group gatherings and town halls in all parish churches to check in with church members; to hold discussions and find out what people have on their hearts.
- Pastor Melissa likes visiting informally with people one-on-one.
- She thinks all parish churches have completed their Statistics Reports that were due today, and submitted them to the Conference. She thanked Dave and all who helped him to get Wesley's numbers together.
- She shared with us the composition of a Single Board Model for meeting. In all other parish churches, the Ad Council, SPRC, Finance and Trustees Committees meet once a month and function as one board of directors. Discussion is held and decisions are made by representatives of each area in the format of one board. Members only sit in one meeting versus many per month. On the board level, someone is accountable. Trustees can have 2 specific people – one in charge of property, buildings and maintenance and the other in charge of contracts, insurance and legal issues. They can recruit anyone needed but the decision making is made by the one central committee instead of separate committees. Everyone knows what needs to be done across the whole church. Linda brought up some recent Trustee issues that, as temporary chair, she is having some difficulty with, and doesn't know how the Single Board Model will function in similar situations. Dave gave some examples of how it could work. He reaches out to other people for assistance. He thinks it will be a good thing. Melissa agreed and said that the entire committee can give support in the various situations. Jan said we have to decide who takes responsibility for what. Will need to have things clearly laid out.

Jan had a question regarding SPRC confidential issues. Melissa said that if there are persons present who are not part of the Council, they would be excused from the meeting and then the confidential SPRC matters could then be discussed.

After further discussion, it was decided to table the discussion and have a small group of representatives from Trustees, Finance, SPRC and Ad Council meet to work on a proposal to bring to the entire Council at the next meeting. Could have sub-groups meeting separately and reporting to the larger group.

Staff Parish Relations Committee

SPRC meeting 01/14/2026

SPRC Committee along with Pastor Melissa met for the 1st meeting of the new year. There were 3 SPRC members in attendance, along with Pastor Melissa.

- Pastor Melissa shared her goals for 2026. She will share those goals at the next Ad Council mtg. We will use these goals to perform her annual evaluation at the end of this year prior to church conference.
- Pastor Melissa discussed the "One Board Model" explaining briefly how it works. The other NCCP churches use this model. Pastor Melissa will be discussing this model at the next Ad Council mtg. Brenda would like to sit in on a meeting of another church parish to see how it works.

- Our committee will need to have new members come on board at the end of this year due to members coming off the committee. Current committee members service term will at year's end, 2026. We will need to fill these vacancies for 2027. She thinks we could use the rotation system again.
- Pastor Melissa will work with Wesley's committee on nominations to reinstate the rotation system to help select church members from the congregation to fill open committee vacancies on various committees. This will help to develop the ministry direction of the congregation and pastor for the future.

Meeting was cut short due to the Zoom meeting only allowing 45 minutes for the meeting.

Our next meeting will be April 8th, 2026.

Finance Committee: Dave Hudgins, Church Treasurer – Reports available upon request.

- Balance Sheet – Year end reports. Opened an RBC transferred some of the checking account to this fund to make some interest income.
- Bottom line – total income exceeded total expenses mainly due to the Employee Credit Retention (ERC) refund which kept us in good shape.
- Income – made a nice up tic near the end of the year
- Expenses – Up from last year, which was expected. NCCP and staff salaries were up from last year as were mission share and utilities. Due to WIP and HVAC, ended overbudget.
- Dave transferred funds to the WIP fund to cover already planned projects.
- The Cemetery is a separate LLC. It would like to use Quick Books and the finance computer. Agent suggested that the church insurance coverage should remain the same. Dave suggested we could charge 10% of our insurance premium and 10% of our Quick Books for the usage. Denny thought 10% is too high. Could have two separate policies. Will be determined later.
- He sent out the Statistical Report to Conference.
- Dave said he would be willing to step up to learn Servant Keeper if someone would teach him.
- The issue is who has administrative access to set up a separate user name and password. Dawn knows her way around Servant Keeper and may have administrative access. Dave will track it down.
- Need to do a full audit. Haven't done one in a number of years. Will be discussed at the Finance meeting. Will decide if we want to do it internally or hire someone.

United Methodist Men's Group: Dave Hudgins, President

- The group has continued to meet monthly; has had some nice breakfasts. Over the year 2025 has supported Westminster Rescue Mission, Carroll County Veterans Improvement Project, Wesley Food Pantry. Will meet again for breakfast on Feb. 17 and will host the Shrove Tuesday Supper that evening at 5 p.m. until around 7 p.m.

Trustees: Linda Yost, member

- Linda asked Denny if he had anything to add to Dave's discussion of the meeting of the new Cemetery LLC. Not at this time.
- May need to check if the Weavers will be shoveling the sidewalks and steps. The parking lot is taken care of by the Lippy family.
- The Scout trailer, which is owned by Wesley UMC, was being used by the Leader, James Kirby, during a Scout camping outing over the recent snowy weekend. When going up a hill, James' truck lost traction on the icy back road and slid backwards with the trailer. The trailer jack-knifed

and went into a tree, causing damage to the back and roof. The trailer also caused damage to James' truck. No one was injured in the accident. State Farm will cover the damage to the trailer up to \$2500. Wesley does not carry comprehensive coverage. An older trailer had liability coverage, but not the current one. The question Linda had was should Wesley carry comprehensive/collision along with liability coverage on the trailer? It was agreed that we should explore the price of both. If not that much money, should go ahead and do both.

- There is a pine limb down in the parsonage back/side yard. Need to either ask someone from church or Ryan (tenant) to cut it up and remove. Or can hire it out.
- Linda is concerned that Trustees needs to add members to the Committee. Need to ask at church.
