



Wesley UMC Outreach Committee Minutes



March 12, 2025, 6 p.m. – via ZOOM

Members present: Jan Kurtz, Janet Martin, Brenda Kennedy, Connie Wiegel, Michelle Hudgins, Linda Yost

Jan opened the meeting with prayer. Between meetings, it was communicated to Jan by the Whitcomb family that a church in their area had paid the entire repair bill on their car. They will not need the \$200 donation from our committee. Also, Shirley Rytel, a relative of a church member, asked for assistance in paying her electric bill, which totaled \$306. Via email, the Outreach Committee agreed to pay this so her electric would not be turned off.

Treasurer's Report

Linda reported that she had reviewed the bank statements and check book entries. She is up to date on the entries and assuming the Met Ed check of \$306 for Shirley will show up as cleared on April's bank statement, the checkbook balance as of March 12, 2025 is \$2,622.70. Made \$185.00 from the Potato Luncheon. It's difficult to rely on our reduced congregation to have a high attendance at after-worship events. It was a nice event. Received \$891.00 from Bazaar. Every month we pay for our Compassion Child (\$43). Linda will pay donations to the Westminster Rescue Mission (\$100) and NESAP (\$125) during this first quarter. In 2025, we will pay out a total of \$1416 to these three organizations. This was agreed upon by the committee. Janet asked if the church would be giving the Outreach Committee some funding. Linda stated that if we ask, they will. It is in the church budget. We will review in the fall to see if we need to ask.

Meals

· Patty Harris has taken over handling meals. No one is receiving meals at this time.

College Students - Gift Cards

· Linda will purchase 12 Amazon gift cards (\$25.00 each) and send them to the college students.

Easter Baskets

- · Put out 24 buckets for our congregation to fill. Vicky donated the buckets and Linda will send a thank-you to her.
- · Buckets are due back to church by Sunday, March 23, 2025 and need to be delivered to Shepherd Staff by March 28, 2025. Will meet after church on the 23rd to wrap in the clear plastic bags.

Night By Night Shelter

· Janet reported that when she took over the winter items collected by our church that the coordinator at the Shelter said they are not taking cold weather items now. They did take what Janet had and will put them in storage. The Sunday School had been collecting winter items as well for the Shelter. Janet discussed this with Jackie Otwell, Sunday School Superintendent, and the items could be put into storage at Wesley until next year. The other possibility is for the items to be donated to a Shelter in Westminster on Distillery Road. It was originally the Women's Shelter, but now houses families. Night by Night does appreciate the breakfast foods we donate. The chili cookoff raised about \$2,000. We will continue to donate breakfast foods.

Dove House

- During Lent, from March 9 April 13, 2025, the Caring Parish donation drive for the entire NCCP is for "Bridging Life Hospice Care" at Dove house next to Carroll Hospital.
- · At participating locations, we are collecting various snacks and food items. These comfort food items serve as a means of hospitality to the families of the patients entering into end-of- life care. The following snacks are recommended:




