

Sacred Scripture

In this next Catechism about joy admits the cross, I will talk about the integrity of peace. Peace is the storage container of joy. Peace is the trampoline on which joy can jump. Peace is the room and joy is the air. The peace of Christ is the fruit of being in a right relationship with God. We participate in that right relationship by: believing in Jesus, participating in the sacraments and choosing God's will over ours.

Two ways that we can rob ourselves of peace is by not choosing to trust in God and by either procrastinating or not going to confession. The sacrament of confession is the act of reconciling with God. When we go before the priest in the confessional, we are going before Jesus Christ. Jesus is the one who forgives us with the words of his priests. Jesus is the one who restores us to integrity with the hands of his priests.

When we are at peace with God, nothing can rob us of our peace and joy. The cross becomes a work with Jesus and sometimes that work is grueling and difficult but it still is working with Jesus. How can we not be at peace and in joy when we are working with our Lord and friend Jesus Christ?
