Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

I am writing to clarify some positions. The pope is the successor of Saint Peter as both bishop of Rome, Italy and shepherd of the entire body of Christ the Church. He has an obligation to promote the love of God and the peace of Christ throughout the world. The president of the United States has the responsibility for leading our nation in order with the dictates of our constitution. As commander in chief, he is responsible for protecting our national sovereignty and security from enemies foreign and domestic. As a leader of a nation, he is also responsible for protecting other nations from acts of tyranny and terror.

St Thomas Aquinas illustrates what a civic leader is responsible for when war is needed to be declared. Aquinas, as he is often called in theology studies, gave us a good standard to follow in his just war theory. In his work, Summa Theologiae, II-II, question 40, he offers three necessary conditions for a war to be just. The first is to have a Legitimate Authority (auctoritas principis): War must be declared by a lawful sovereign, not by private individuals. The second is to have a Just Cause (causa iusta): There must be a real and grave reason for war to be declared. The third is to have a Right Intention (intent recta): The goal must be to advance good and/or avoid evil, not vengeance or conquest.

Aquinas emphasized that these conditions do not make war a good in itself. War is a sad necessity, not a virtue. The aim is peace, not perpetual conflict. Blessed are the peacemakers for they will be called the children of God.
