The citations noted their ongoing commitment to finding, preserving and sharing local history and are outlined below:

Trudy Cowan: For her outstanding contribution to the preservation of Alberta's history. In addition to her volunteer work with the Jewish Historical Society of Southern Alberta, she has served in leadership roles on many national and provincial boards. She has published several books illustrating local history.

Shelia Johnston: For her contribution to Alberta's heritage as an educator, a scholar, a volunteer and a professional. She has held leadership positions in heritage organizations where she practiced her core beliefs that heritage conservation education and interpretation must be accurate and authentic.

Harry Sanders: As a researcher, author, active presenter and in leadership roles, he has delved into Southern Alberta history, primarily Calgary, for many years. His talks, media appearances and writings have been instrumental in engaging the public in the appreciation of and the preservation of history.


