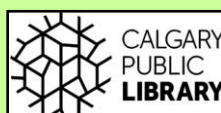
Historic Calgary Week 2021 Is A Go!

Your HCW 2021 Committee has arranged for about 45 events, comprised of 31 outdoor events and 14 virtual events. As usual, there is something for everyone – from panel discussions, to walks, to bike rides, to story time for kids. We are excited!

With the continuing success in vaccinations in Alberta, we are optimistic that these events will proceed from July 23 through August 2 as planned, subject to any restrictions that may apply at the time. At this point we cannot guarantee that the outdoor events can proceed if restrictions remain in place. Whatever restrictions are in place we will limit attendance at all outdoor events at an as yet undetermined level. We may as well encourage attendees to wear masks regardless of the restrictions at the time.

Precise details will be outlined about 2 weeks before the beginning of the festival. Welcome to summer!

We have wrapped up the virtual presentations for 20/21 in collaboration with our great partner, the Calgary Public Library. In total 21 presentations were delivered since August 2020. These were viewed by more than 1450 households. Topics ranged from geology, to art, to historic neighbourhoods/places/communities, projects and the people who have made unique contributions to our area. We recognize the splendid work of the Presenters who informed, educated and entertained.

Work has continued on the development of the App, now known as Calgary Story. Some filming is scheduled for June and we hope restrictions will ease to allow for an expanded schedule in the near future.

Planning for Historic Calgary Week 2021, July 23 to August 2 is well underway. Virtual presentations will be delivered through our partnership with the Calgary Public Library. In addition, we hope to offer a variety of tours and walks, if we are allowed to do so. These will require pre-registration and be subject to restrictions as per AHS Orders. Although we anticipate that the event will be smaller, we are expecting it to be just as memorable. We are planning to publish a Historic Crossword puzzle. We recognize the hard work of a dedicated group of volunteers who are organizing the events and thank them for all that they do. We will not be printing a brochure due to the uncertainty around restrictions etc. but event information and registration information will be on our website at **www.chinookhistory.ca** as soon as it is available.

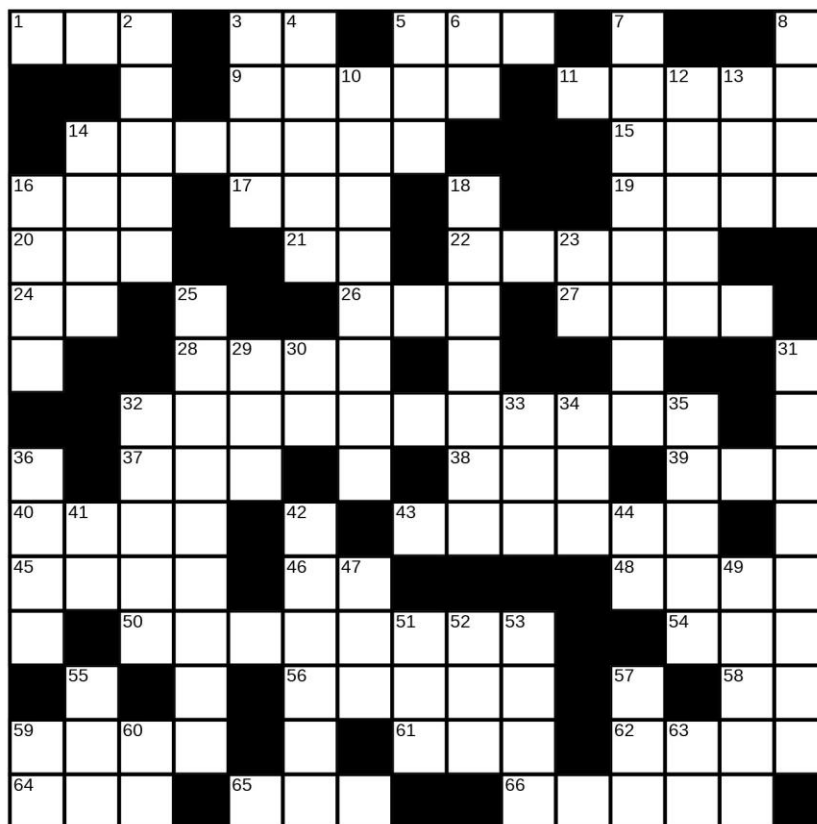
Looking for help with French Canadian Genealogical research and to build the French side of your family tree?
