Historic Calgary Week 2022

July 22- August 1

Historic Calgary Week 2022 kicks off at 9:45 am on July 22 (doors open 9:15 am) with our opening ceremonies followed by four programs at the Memorial Building of the Southern Alberta Pioneers and Their Descendants. Mayor Jyoti Gondek has been invited to open our 11-day history festival.

Our program will comprise over 65 in-person and virtual programs in Calgary and region, including Nanton, High River, Okotoks, Chestermere, Irricana, and Rosebud. We'll soar to new heights with the F-86 at The Hangar Museum and dig into the findings of the archaeologists and paleontologists. The experiences of our pioneers and immigrants over the decades will highlight several of the presentations. Visits to churches, parks, museums, and communities will explore the history of the places we call home.

In recognition of potential health concerns in the community, we are limiting attendance at in-person events to a maximum of 40 participants or less to accommodate individual circumstances. Pre-registration will be required for most events.

Take a Road Trip Around Alberta while tackling our Giant HCW Crossword Puzzle. We plan to publish it in the Calgary Herald on July 22 and have it posted to our website on the same day. 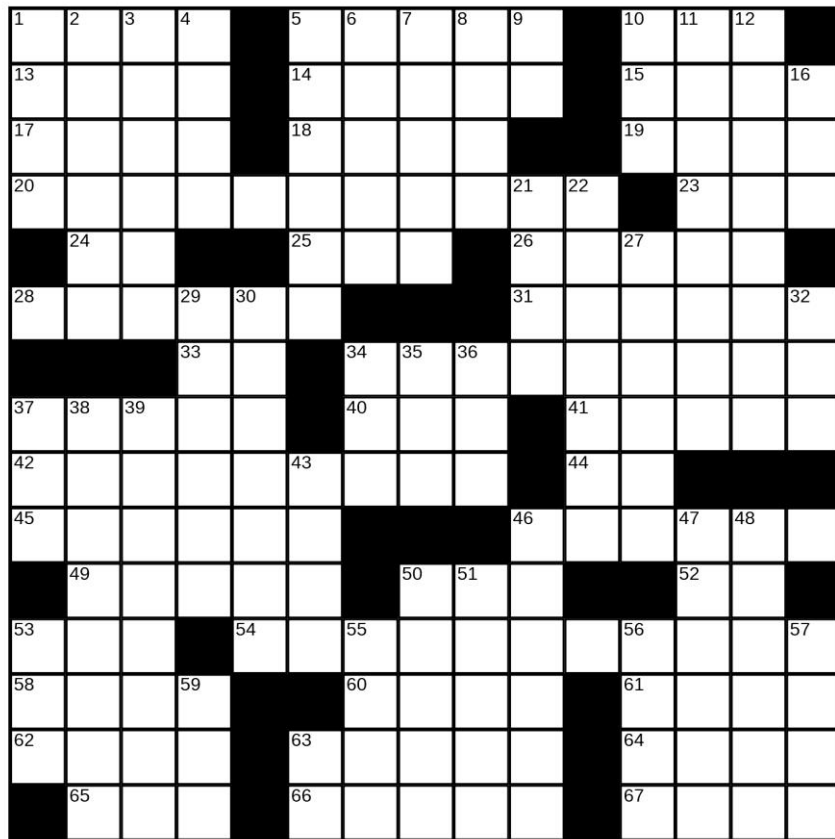
Volunteer for Historic Calgary Week!

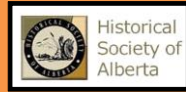
