**First Vice President Needed!**

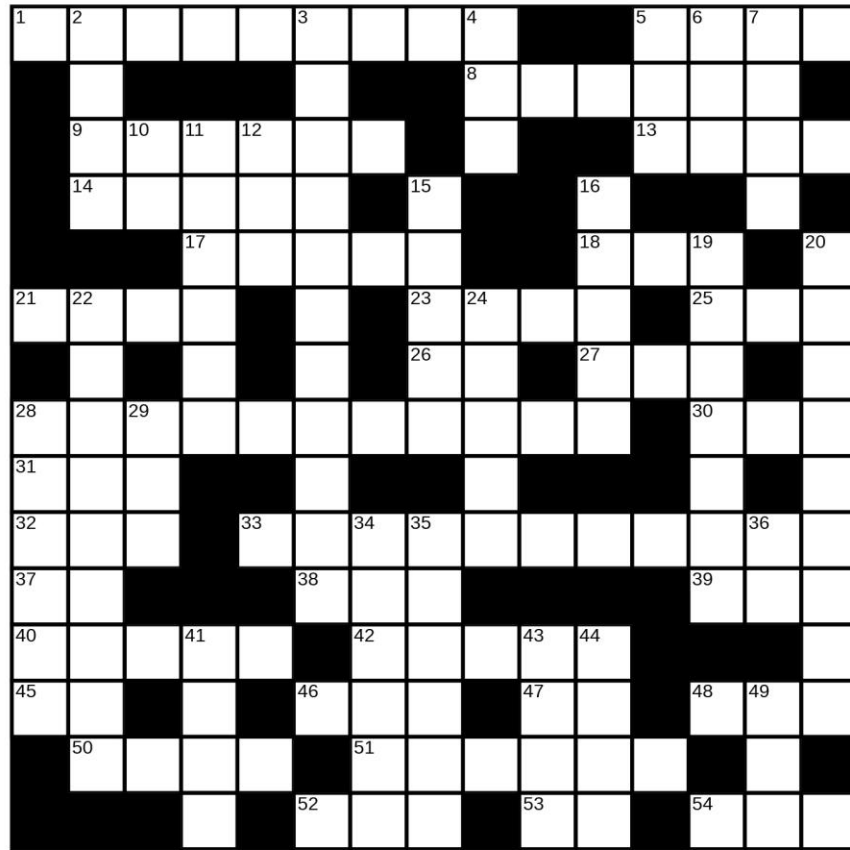
Would you like to be a voice for local history and contribute to making a difference in our community?

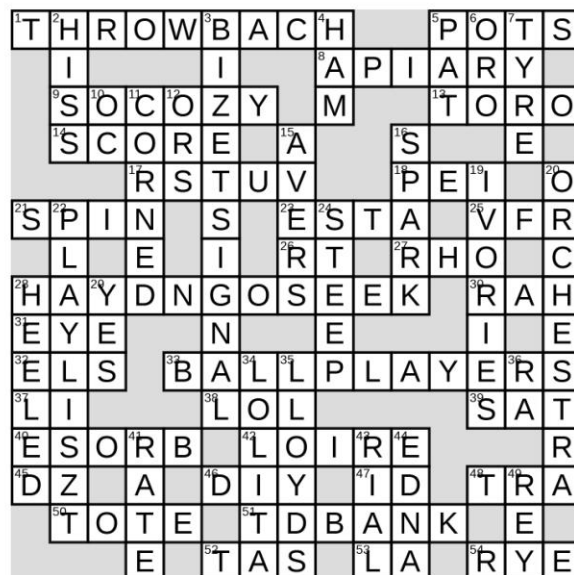
