History Hunt 2021 answers

I used the Sherlock's Map of Calgary 22nd Edition as a reference for the Residential Community Names.

I added some notes below as some of the answers listed are for named residential areas that are part of a larger residential community. A couple of answers are former community names for an area that has now become part of a larger community. Some of the answers are for new communities that are presently being developed. There may be a few other community names not included below that would qualify.

1. Name five communities that end in the word "dale".

Abbeydale, Douglasdale, Glendale, Martindale, Parkdale, Riverdale, Rosedale, Taradale.

2. Name three communities that begin or end in the word "glen".

Glenbrook, Glendale, Glengarry, Douglas Glen, MacEwan Glen, North Glenmore Park.

3. Name three communities that have the name of an animal as part of the community name.

Cougar Ridge, Deer Ridge, Deer Run, Lynx Ridge, Wolf Willow.

4. Name three communities that have the name of a bird as part of the community name.

Eagle Ridge, Falconridge, Hawkwood, Meadowlark Park. (*I included Hawkwood although it is the name of the family who used to live on the land prior to the development of the community*).

5. Name six communities that include one of these directions as part of the community name (North, South, West). (*The direction East was not included in the History Hunt so I didn't include East Village as an answer*).

North Haven, South Calgary, Southview, Southwood, Westgate, West Hillhurst, West Macleod, West Springs.

6. Name six communities that include a colour as part of the community name.

(I included quite a variety of names for this question).

Auburn Bay, Copperfield, Coral Springs, Garrison Green, Greenview, Greenwood, Red Carpet, Redstone, Silverado, Silver Springs, Whitehorn.

7. Name five communities that are named after a person or family with a personal connection to Calgary.

Albert Park, Christie Park, Cranston, Currie, Dover, Hanson Ranch, Hawkwood, Haysboro, Hotchkiss, Hounsfield Heights, MacEwan Glen, Nolan Hill, Patterson, Point McKay, Ramsay, Shawnee Slopes, Shawnessy. (I did not include Strathcona as he may have passed through the city on the train but I don't think he ever resided here. I did not include Palliser or Rundle as they were in this area before Fort Calgary was built).

8. Name six communities that include the name of a tree in the community name.

Applewood Park, Aspen Woods, Cedarbrae, Evergreen, Maple Ridge, Oakridge, Pineridge, Royal Oak, Spruce Cliff, Willow Park, Wolf Willow.
