On April 9, 2020, the Alberta Government enacted Ministerial Order No. SA:009/2020; suspending the obligation to convene an in-person Annual General Meeting as stipulated in section 25 of the *Societies Act* (Alberta). **This virtual meeting replaces the previously cancelled AGM originally scheduled for March 24, 2020.**

All of our programs, including Historic Calgary Week, have been cancelled through to at least the end of August 2020. Our HCW 2020 committee had already organized another interesting program with over 80 events and was ready to go to press when the decision to cancel was made. We will hold over these events and hopefully most of our presenters will be able to be part of HCW 2021.

Not everything has come to a standstill – work on our Mobile History App is continuing albeit with a modified operating plan. The virtual shutdown of activities makes videotaping impossible, but work continues on the research for all 10 of our episodes and hopefully videotaping can resume in the fall. Our efforts on this project have been enhanced with the addition of eight volunteers from the University of Calgary History Department.


