UTOPIA'S MUST-HAVE PHOTO SPOTS



DREAMWORKS CHARACTERS

Plan specific times to meet and photograph favorite characters near the Boardwalk and Central Park.

BOARDWALK AMBIENCE

Capture the neon lights and merry-go-round charm, especially at sunset or evening within the Boardwalk.

CENTRAL PARK GREENERY

Use natural light. Photograph the unique plants and fine dining facades for distinct ship-life memories.

SKY WALK THRILLS

Take a photo looking through the glass floor. Tilt the unique vantage point for an engaging shot of the deck.

PERFECT DAY AT COCOCAY: BEACH ACTION SHOTS



THRILL WATERPARK

Capture action shots! Pose with friends on multi-slide structures or go with a waterproof camera.

COCO BEACH CLUB CABANAS

Book a beachfront or overwater cabana. Use it as a perfect, relaxed backdrop for tropical photos.

OASIS LAGOON FUN

Try dynamic photos at the swim-up bar and pool (ensure your camera is protected!)

TRANQUIL BEACHES

Head to simpler beaches like South Beach for relaxed, artistic shots of palm trees and ocean.



NASSAU, BAHAMAS: ARCHITECTURAL GEMS



PARLIAMENT SQUARE

Capture the vibrant pink buildings. Use wide angles to include the colonial detail and surrounding flags.



QUEEN'S STAIRCASE (66 Steps)

Walk up the historic, lush steps. Plan for early light for dramatic shadows and fewer crowds.



STRAW MARKET

Deeply immersive. Document the textures of the woven items and the lively, colorful craft market buzz.



FORT CHARLOTTE

Visit the massive 18th-century fort. Photograph the cannons and commanding ocean views.



PRO-LEVEL CRUISE PHOTO TIPS



RULE OF THIRDS & GRIDLINES

For professional shots, activate gridlines. Place key subjects off-center for visual balance.



EMBRACE GOLDEN HOUR

Capitalize on the warm, soft light just after sunrise and before sunset for ship and island landscapes.



EXPERIMENT WITH ANGLES

Get low for unique perspectives. Take photos from high spots for expansive deck or island views.



AVOID CROWDS

Early morning (before 8am) is perfect for people-free shots of public venues on the ship.
