Welcome back for another great quilty year!

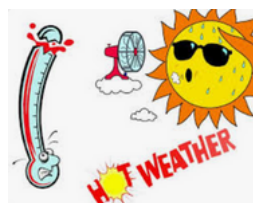

Trim off the selvages, make a single turning on all four sides, and hem with a stitch of your choice. These blankets are greatly appreciated.

Thanks to Louise, Alice and Karolyn, we were able to give 17 in August. We received several donations of fleece yardage over the summer, so I am planning to bring some to guild on the 16th for anyone interested in helping with the hemming.

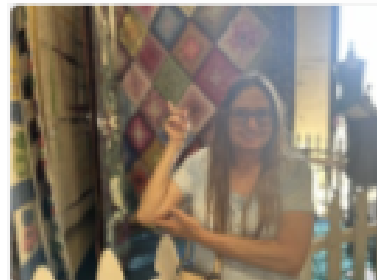
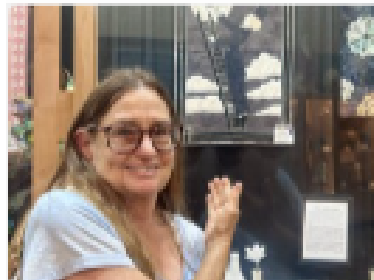
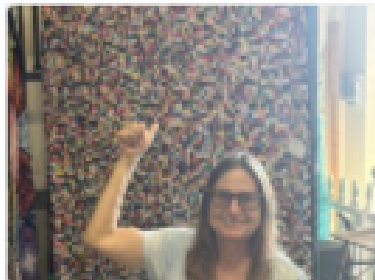
