Membership

Again, there are no membership updates for you this month. However, I do have something for the Guild membership. It's sort of a challenge, and with all the time on our hands, I thought this just might be the right time to give it out.

NOTE: Just because your sewing machine may have a ¹/₄" foot, that doesn't mean that you can sew a quarter inch finished seam for piecing together quilt blocks. Here is how you can....

Quarter Inch Seam Allowance Test

1. Accurately cut three (3) 1¹/₂ " x 3 ¹/₂" strips.



2. Sew three strips together using $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam.



Press square, with seams toward the center strip.
The block should measure 3 ¹/₂" in all directions.


If not.... two solutions:

Move the needle (if your sewing machine allows)... 1. To the LEFT if square is greater than 3 ½ inches 2. To the RIGHT if square is smaller than 3 ½ inches

Repeat steps 1 thru 4 over and over again.....until you get a perfect 3 ¹/₂" square!

IMPORTANT: When you have settings that result in making a 3 ^{1/2}" square – **RECORD THEM FOR FUTURE USE**.

You might want to use a piece of purple tape or blue painter's tape to make a fabric guide so you can obtain your ¹/₄" sewn seam.
