Several boxes were donated to Patio Playhouse, a local Community Theater Group that will use the mixed fabrics for costumes, sets, and their youth summer theater program. Founded in 1967, Patio Playhouse is the oldest continuously-operating community theater in Northern San Diego County. Patio Playhouse is especially important in our community as they do not charge for youth auditions or participation, so they rely on donations like these. This fabric was a mix of quilting fabric that had not been bought in our White Elephant sales, and was also passed over by the public at our test sale in December.

Please see Connie at the February Meeting to pick up your tickets. Just a reminder it is expected per the by laws that each guild member sells \$20.00.


Quilt Challenge
