

Financial Transparency

Plains Preparatory Institute is committed to responsible stewardship, financial accountability, and transparency as we work to establish a premier boarding school for young men focused on leadership, STEM education, agriculture, and workforce readiness.

As a newly established nonprofit organization, Plains Preparatory Institute's current fiscal year concludes on June 30, 2026. Because the organization has not yet completed a full fiscal year of operations, an IRS Form 990 is not currently available. Following the close of our fiscal year and completion of all required reporting, Form 990 documentation will be made available in accordance with applicable nonprofit regulations.

To date, Plains Preparatory Institute has received approximately \$11,000 in charitable contributions and donations. These funds have been used to support organizational planning, program development, fundraising, administrative operations, and the foundational work required to establish the institution.

The Institute maintains financial oversight through its Board of Directors and leadership team. Treasurer Megan Holden works closely with organizational leadership to ensure responsible financial management, accurate recordkeeping, and adherence to nonprofit governance standards. This oversight helps ensure that all contributions are managed appropriately and in alignment with the Institute's mission and long-term objectives.
