## SEA-INTELLIGENCE: TRANSPACIFIC CAPACITY REVERSAL

Sea-Intelligence reports that carriers injected ~770,000 TEU of extra capacity into Transpacific routes during the 90-day U.S. tariff pause. But as demand cooled and rates fell, carriers quickly pulled back 23–24% of that capacity by early July.

This reflects the market's growing agility in balancing supply against demand fluctuations.

#### ROBERTS BANK TERMINAL 2 PROCUREMENT PHASE BEGINS

The Vancouver Fraser Port Authority has launched the Request for Qualifications (RFQ) for the wharf and landmass phase of the Roberts Bank Terminal 2 project.

The project is expected to:

- Add \$3 billion/year to Canada's GDP
- Support over \$100 billion in annual trade
- Create 18,000+ jobs

# CMA CGM ADDS ZEEBRUGGE CALL TO IRISH SEA EXPRESS

CMA CGM will enhance its short-sea Irish Sea Express (ISX) service by adding a Zeebrugge call starting Week 30 (mid-July).

This update will:

- Improve links between Ireland, UK, and Central Europe
- Strengthen access to Far East and Baltic feeder networks
- Support CMA CGM's regional short-sea logistics strategy

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## IMO WARNS OF RENEWED RED SEA ATTACKS

The IMO Secretary-General has called for constructive diplomatic dialogue following a renewed wave of attacks on shipping in the Red Sea.

Since late 2023, 69 incidents have been recorded, impacting vessels transiting key global trade lanes such as the Bab el-Mandeb and Suez Canal.

Operators are urged to review risk assessments and routing plans amid heightened regional tension.

### CSTAR LINE LAUNCHES CHINA-RED SEA SERVICE

CStar Line will launch a new China-Red Sea loop (FRS1) offering twice-monthly sailings.

The route connects Ningbo, Shanghai, and Guangzhou to Jeddah, Aqaba, and Sokhna, using four vessels (1,600–2,000 TEU).

This direct service strengthens China–Middle East connectivity and adds alternative options for East–West trades amid Suez-related disruptions.
