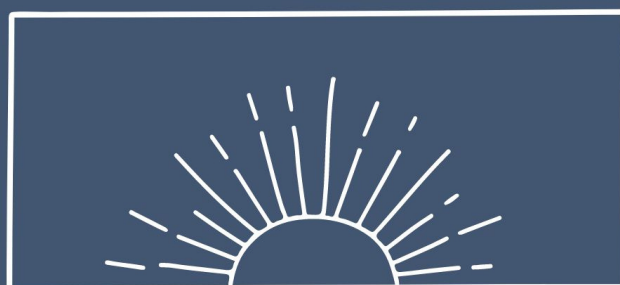
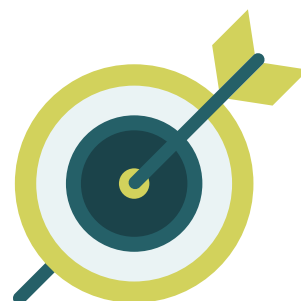
BRING ANY LEGAL PAPERS
