

# Money Movez: Cook or Be Cooked Board Game - Instructions

## **Objective of the Game**

In "Money Movez: Cook or Be Cooked," your goal is to help your character achieve a financial target while mastering essential financial concepts. You'll navigate real-life scenarios in personal finance, entrepreneurship, and investing. The winner is the player who successfully manages their money and reaches or exceeds their financial goal first!

## **How to Play**

# 1.Players

The game supports up to four players. Each player will select a character and a life goal from the provided list. For example, Stock Shark (Player 1) might choose to save \$5,000 for a new car.

### 2. Movement and Turns

Players roll dice to move around the board. Each space presents financial challenges or rewards. Players must make wise decisions as they navigate the board, facing opportunities and setbacks that either help or hinder their progress.

#### **Game Cards Elements**

- •Wisecoin Cards (Blue Deck): Gain wisdom, financial knowledge, and rewards by drawing from the Wisecoin deck. For example, refinancing a mortgage could add \$300 to your total savings.
- •Financial Gain Cards (Yellow Deck): Answer financial questions to earn money. Correct answers add \$200 to your balance; wrong answers force you to pull from the Debt Pitfall deck.
- •Debt Pitfall Cards (Red Deck): These represent financial setbacks such as debt or unexpected expenses. Some cards offer opportunities (like life insurance payouts), but most will cost you money.

### Icons on the Board:

•Bull Icon: Land here to answer a financial question. If correct, earn \$200; if wrong, pull a Debt Pitfall card.



- •Water Slide Icon: Move up or down the board based on the outcome of a slide.
- •Red Car Icon: Pay \$1,000 and skip your next turn. If you don't have the money, you can take a loan from Mr. Interest. If you don't want to take a loan, you must skip your next turn and wait until your next opportunity to move.
  - •Crash Icon: Move back four spaces and draw a Debt Pitfall card.
  - •Credit Card Icon: Pay \$300 in credit card interest.
- •Bonus Icon: Move ahead four spaces and draw a Wisecoin card for extra rewards.
- •Bond Icon: Hidden in the Wisecoin deck, bonds provide a secret advantage for the player.
  - •Bear Icon: Move three spaces back when you land on this space.
- •Rain Cloud Icon: Roll the dice and move back based on the number shown.
- •Three Coin Green Arrow: Provides a hidden advantage that helps you jump ahead or stay in place.
- •Jail Icon: Land here, and you'll sit out one round unless you answer a financial question to escape.

## **Special Features**

- •Extra Challenge Button: If a player can't answer a question, another player can press this button to "steal" the question for a \$200 reward. They have 45 seconds to answer.
- •Pitfall Risk: Incorrect answers result in drawing a card from the Debt Pitfall deck, potentially setting players further back.



### **How to Win**

To win, players must:

- •Reach their financial goal with a 25% overage.
- •Answer three Financial Gain questions correctly near the end of the game. Missing a question means rolling the dice and moving backward.
- •If a player reaches the top without meeting their goal, they must roll back to earn more money before moving forward again.

# **Additional Gameplay Rules**

- •Game Tracker Role: The Game Tracker monitors players' progress using the Cook Calculator (accessible via a QR code), tracking profits, losses, and financial goals in real-time.
- •Journal Requirement: Players must keep a journal throughout the game, noting their financial decisions and learning from each scenario.
- •Real-World Learning: Each card and scenario reflects real-life financial concepts, helping players understand money management, debt, and investing.
