Purpose

The Money Movez Club empowers students to develop an entrepreneurial mindset by connecting their passions, skills, and interests to real-world financial literacy and business creation. Students learn how money works, how businesses are built, and how to turn ideas into action.

- Develop a basic website or digital platform
- Use Money Movez digital tools and app
- Write a business plan
- Pitch a final business concept

Program Structure

Meetings are held 1–2 times per month after school on campus. The program includes hands-on workshops, team collaboration, guest speakers, approved field trips, and digital tool integration.

Core Learning Areas

Entrepreneurial Mindset, Personal Finance, Business Fundamentals, Branding & Marketing, Website & Digital Tools, Business Plan Development, Pitching & Presentation Skills.

Field Trips & Experiences

Students may participate in approved visits to banks, credit unions, local businesses, colleges, incubators, and entrepreneurship events. All trips follow district procedures.

Capstone Requirement

Each student must complete a business plan, brand and website, and deliver a final pitch presentation during the Money Movez Showcase.
