ARTICLE I – NAME

THE NAME OF THIS ORGANIZATION SHALL BE MONEY MOVEZ: COOK OR BE COOKED. FINANCIAL LITERACY & ENTREPRENEURSHIP CLUB, HEREAFTER REFERRED TO AS "MONEY MOVEZ: COOK OR BE COOKED CLUB."

ARTICLE II – PURPOSE & MISSION

THE PURPOSE OF THE MONEY MOVEZ CLUB IS TO ACTIVATE STUDENTS' ENTREPRENEURIAL MINDSET BY HELPING THEM DISCOVER THEIR PASSIONS, DEVELOP FINANCIAL LITERACY, AND BUILD REAL-WORLD BUSINESS SKILLS.

MISSION OBJECTIVES:

- TEACH PERSONAL FINANCE FUNDAMENTALS (BUDGETING, SAVING, CREDIT, INVESTING).
- GUIDE STUDENTS TO IDENTIFY THEIR PASSION AND SKILL SET.
- SUPPORT STUDENTS IN CREATING A REAL BUSINESS IDEA.
- DEVELOP STUDENT UNDERSTANDING OF BRANDING, MARKETING, AND DIGITAL PRESENCE.
- PREPARE STUDENTS TO WRITE AND PITCH A BUSINESS PLAN.
- EXPOSE STUDENTS TO ENTREPRENEURSHIP THROUGH FIELD TRIPS, GUEST SPEAKERS, AND COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIPS.
- USE THE MONEY MOVEZ DIGITAL TOOLS AND APP TO REINFORCE LEARNING AND ACCOUNTABILITY.

ARTICLE III – AUTHORITY & COMPLIANCE

THE MONEY MOVEZ CLUB SHALL OPERATE IN FULL COMPLIANCE WITH:

- PUBLIC SCHOOLS POLICIES
- SCHOOL ADMINISTRATION GUIDELINES
- STATE AND FEDERAL EDUCATION REGULATIONS
- CLUB ADVISOR HANDBOOK

ALL MEETINGS, ACTIVITIES, AND FIELD TRIPS MUST BE APPROVED BY THE SCHOOL ADMINISTRATION AND SUPERVISED BY THE CLUB ADVISOR.

ARTICLE IV – MEMBERSHIP

1. MEMBERSHIP IS OPEN TO ALL CURRENTLY ENROLLED STUDENTS AT THE SCHOOL.
2. NO STUDENT SHALL BE DENIED MEMBERSHIP BASED ON RACE, GENDER, RELIGION, DISABILITY, SOCIOECONOMIC STATUS, OR BACKGROUND.
3. MEMBERS MUST:
 - MAINTAIN A MINIMUM 2.0 GPA
 - FOLLOW SCHOOL CONDUCT POLICIES
 - ATTEND MEETINGS REGULARLY
 - ACTIVELY PARTICIPATE IN CLUB PROJECTS



ARTICLE V – STUDENT OUTCOMES & REQUIREMENTS

TO REMAIN IN GOOD STANDING, EACH STUDENT MUST COMPLETE THE FOLLOWING DURING THE SCHOOL YEAR:

- IDENTIFY A PERSONAL PASSION OR SKILL
- CREATE A BUSINESS IDEA CONNECTED TO THAT PASSION
- DEVELOP:
 - A BASIC BRAND IDENTITY
 - A WEBSITE OR DIGITAL PRESENCE
- USE THE MONEY MOVEZ APP AND TOOLS FOR FINANCIAL LEARNING
- PARTICIPATE IN AT LEAST ONE APPROVED FIELD TRIP
- COMPLETE A WRITTEN BUSINESS PLAN
- PITCH THEIR BUSINESS IDEA AT THE MONEY MOVEZ SHOWCASE

ARTICLE VI – MEETINGS

- MEETINGS WILL BE HELD AT LEAST ONCE PER MONTH, AFTER SCHOOL, ON CAMPUS.
- ADDITIONAL WORK SESSIONS MAY BE SCHEDULED FOR:
 - WEBSITE BUILDING
 - BRANDING WORKSHOPS
 - BUSINESS PLAN DEVELOPMENT
- THE ADVISOR MUST BE PRESENT AT ALL MEETINGS.
- MEETING MINUTES AND ATTENDANCE WILL BE RECORDED AND STORED IN THE CLUB BINDER.

ARTICLE VII – OFFICERS

PRESIDENT

- LEADS MEETINGS AND ACTIVITIES
- KEEPS MEMBERS ON TASK AND ENGAGED
- WORKS WITH ADVISOR TO PLAN PROGRAMMING

VICE PRESIDENT

- ASSISTS THE PRESIDENT
- LEADS MEETINGS IN PRESIDENT'S ABSENCE

SECRETARY

- RECORDS MEETING MINUTES
- MANAGES ATTENDANCE
- COMMUNICATES MEETING REMINDERS

TREASURER

- TRACKS CLUB FUNDS
- WORKS WITH SCHOOL TREASURER PER M-DCPS POLICY
- PRESENTS MONTHLY FINANCIAL UPDATES

MARKETING & MEDIA COORDINATOR

- SUPPORTS BRANDING AND PROMOTIONAL EFFORTS
- HELPS DOCUMENT CLUB ACTIVITIES
- SUPPORTS STUDENT WEBSITES AND DIGITAL TOOLS

ARTICLE IX – ELECTIONS & ELIGIBILITY

- OFFICERS MUST:
 - BE IN GOOD ACADEMIC STANDING
 - HAVE NO MAJOR DISCIPLINARY ISSUES
 - SHOW COMMITMENT TO THE CLUB'S MISSION
- ELECTIONS SHALL BE HELD ANNUALLY.
- OFFICERS MAY BE REMOVED FOR MISCONDUCT FOLLOWING DUE PROCESS.



ARTICLE X – ADVISOR

- THE CLUB SHALL HAVE ONE CERTIFIED TEACHER ADVISOR, APPROVED BY THE PRINCIPAL.
- THE ADVISOR SHALL:
 - SUPERVISE ALL MEETINGS AND ACTIVITIES
 - ENSURE COMPLIANCE WITH SCHOOL AND DISTRICT POLICIES
 - SUPPORT LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT
 - APPROVE FIELD TRIPS, FUNDRAISING, AND EVENTS
 - MAINTAIN REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION

ARTICLE XI – FIELD TRIPS & EXPERIENCES

- **FIELD TRIPS MAY INCLUDE:**
 - BANKS AND CREDIT UNIONS
 - LOCAL BUSINESSES
 - COLLEGES AND INCUBATORS
 - ENTREPRENEURSHIP EVENTS
- ALL TRIPS MUST FOLLOW M-DCPS FIELD TRIP PROCEDURES.
- REQUIRED PERMISSION FORMS MUST BE COMPLETED PRIOR TO TRAVEL.

ARTICLE XII – FINANCES

- ALL FUNDS SHALL BE HANDLED THROUGH THE SCHOOL TREASURER.
- FUNDRAISING MUST BE APPROVED IN ADVANCE.
- NO STUDENT MAY PERSONALLY HANDLE CLUB FUNDS OUTSIDE DISTRICT PROCEDURES.

ARTICLE XIII – AMENDMENTS

THESE BYLAWS MAY BE AMENDED BY A MAJORITY VOTE OF ACTIVE MEMBERS, WITH ADVISOR AND ADMINISTRATIVE APPROVAL.

ARTICLE XIV – DISSOLUTION

IF THE CLUB DISSOLVES, ALL REMAINING FUNDS AND MATERIALS SHALL REVERT TO THE SCHOOL, IN ACCORDANCE WITH DISTRICT POLICY.
