

## **Health Equity Coordinator**

**Part-Time Position (30 hours per week): \$37,500 with limited fringe benefits – 1 year project unless other funding becomes available**

AHA Abenaki Helping Abenaki is currently seeking a candidate for the position of Health Equity Coordinator.

The Health Equity Coordinator will engage Nulhegan tribal citizens across the state and enhance programmatic, education, and implementation strategies that will help decrease health disparities in our community. This work will be in consultation with the AHA Executive Director and tribal leadership.

Health Equity Coordinator will be engaged in the following work:

### **Community Engagement**

The Health Equity Coordinator will create and host community engagement events centered around reinforcing a community-wide sense of cultural awareness and food sovereignty. This may include but not be limited to the Land Link project, food shelf pantry, and activities in collaboration with community partners.

### **Cultural Preservation**

The Health Equity Coordinator will develop and coordinate activities centered around revitalizing cultural and spiritual connection for their citizens.

### **Health and Wellness Initiatives**

The Grantee will create and host wellness events centering around strengthening protective health factors and improving long-term health outcomes in partnership with community health workers. This may include but not be limited to promoting vaccinations and other preventative resources.

### **Environmental Factors:**

Duties will require travel to community sites, for which private means of transportation must be available. Public speaking and attendance at public meetings may be required. Some work outside of normal office hours may be required. Employees are encouraged to work out of their home or in public places. Other needs can be reviewed in an ongoing basis.

### **Preferred Qualifications:**

- High school diploma AND experience working in a community or health care setting is preferred. All applicants will be considered based on lived experiences.
- Understanding of social determinants of health, leading with humility, and cultural competence is what we are looking for in a candidate.
- Human relations within the community and good communication skills should be demonstrated.
