Waste / Rubbish Bins – why are there not more in the park?

Response from HBC (Craig)

There used to be bins (of different types) dotted all over the place in the park. In consultation with the FoRP (before you were involved Ann) we took all the old tatty bins out and replaced them with new dual litter/dog bin stations in key locations — all the main entrance/exit points and one near the centre of the park — as it was felt these were the key places for use. There are also litter bins in the play areas.

Members of the meeting think there is 3 bins in the park – and wonder if this is enough – we need to check numbers and check back with HBC

Spring bulbs have now been planted ready for next season Awaiting timescale for remaining soft landscaping works (re-enstatement) – ground remains very wet.

Coach House / Walled Garden update

Block work continues

Roofing slates have gone on this morning – building almost dried in Dwarf walls for glass house in place – inspected

Drawings for glass house received – approx.. deliver date 20/5/2018 for glass house

Glass House will take 5 days to erect

Site process meeting 15/3/2018 - 7 week delay in build due to weather, catch up when ever possible

By the end of next week, service room and boot room will be ready for roofers

Construction Works for next 2 months

Work on the lying out of the ground for the planter Roofs will be completed

First fix Electric /Plumbing / heating systems followed up by plastering Windows – will be made to measure, presently watertight temporary coverings in place


