Sam and Ziad Kassab, in partnership with Senator Mat Dunaskiss and Eric Castiglia, are hosting their eighth annual “Salute Our Warriors” benefit on Friday, July 11, at the Danny Kassab Estate in Rochester Hills.

The annual benefit is held to honor local military heroes, and serve as a fundraiser for The Fallen and Wounded Soldiers Fund. Each year, the benefit draws a large crowd of dignitaries, supporters, professional athletes, active

military, veterans, law enforcement, and Rosie the Riveters. The event includes a formal ceremony, with honored guests flown in via helicopter onto the lawn of the Kassab estate, according to a press release.

"Everything we do for this annual event is dedicated to honoring our military heroes in the most meaningful ways and giving back to soldiers and families who have served and sacrificed so much to protect our freedom," said Ziad Kassab, who hosts the Annual Salute Our Warriors benefit each year with his father, Sam. "Our goal this year is to raise \$200,000 for The Fallen and Wounded Soldiers Fund and provide a truly unforgettable experience for all of our distinguished veterans and guests!"
