Floating Dock Assembly





(Floats should be mounted first) The frame bolting instructions are shown without floats for clarity Warning: Donot over tighten Bolts, this may cause the nuts to lock up.


Note: each number refers to to a picture number thru-out these instructions, Example: number 1. refers to picture 1.

- 1. Bolt frames together using 2 3/8 x 1" CB. nuts and washers through the frame angles.
- 2. Mount 2 1" U-bolts over the corner angles of the Dock frames. see (Detail A)









 If the Dock requires a section to be bolted off the side, as required for a L-shaped dock, it is best to bolt on the sections between the Cross Bars.

The cross bars are located every 4 foot across the Dock Frames It is best to have the U-Bolts near a Cross Bar picture (3)

An optional Cornerwalk is suggested when using the "L" ot "T" shaped Docks

- 4. With the Dock Frame upside down, center the float between the Cross Bars. (Note) The Float must be aprox. 6 inches away from the end of each section to allow room for bolting the sections together
 - (Detail B1) Bolt on the float mount with $3/8 \times 2 \cdot 1/2$ " bolts, use a standard washer on the head of the bolt (Detail B2) put the Big Washer on first then a standard washer and then the nut.

(Don't over tighten and crush the plastic) snug is good.
