"Mother C" (Artifact in Preparation), August 2018 – December 2020

The final draft of the play that began as "Southside Mother Courage" has become "Mother C". With research funded by a New Frontiers grant, the play has continued to develop and received a public staged reading. Also, the content and presentation of the play changed to include a Deaf character played by a Deaf actor. Accordingly, during the rehearsal period for the public reading of the play, many additional changes were made to the script to more accurately reflect Deaf culture and give a truthful portrayal. The script was further developed and completed in rehearsals with SUNY Buffalo State College for online production. One more version of the script should be developed for in person production, "Southside Mother Courage" (Planning/Design), September 2016 - July 2018 The project will create an adaptation of German playwright Bertolt Brecht's Mother Courage and her Children set on the Chicago Southside. The project will incorporate interviews with Chicago citizens to add another dimension of "authentic voice" to the production.
