
### Hogan's Mill HOA Website Tutorial


### **Home Page**

The Hogan's Mill HOA Website was designed to convey information about the Hogan's Mill Neighborhood. Websites typically have a Home "Page" and then subsequent Pages to navigate to, to allow different information to be conveyed. The HOA website consists of just 3 main pages as follows: The Home Page, The HOA Information Page, and the Neighborhood News Page. When the website is called up, <a href="https://hogansmillhoa.com">https://hogansmillhoa.com</a> it will automatically bring you to the Home Page aforementioned above. At the top of the Home page one will see the Navigation Bar at the top along with the Hogan's Mill HOA Logo. You should see 3 pages listed at the top and as shown in <a href="Slide A">Slide A</a> below.




Slide A-Home Page

Announcements for the Website will be shown with a Green background about half way down the home page as shown below on Slide B.




Slide B-Home Page

If you haven't done so already, the HOA needs your email in order for communication to take place among the entire neighborhood. It will keep you updated, as to when HOA meetings are announced and when the website is updated with the latest information. The website will be updated quarterly for your reference. The "Home" page allows you to input your email in the area shown in Slide C below.

The last part of the Home Page asks for additional information including your email address again. Sorry for the redundancy, but this allows the HOA to update contact information for all the residents within the Hogan's Mill Association. The information goes directly to the webmaster and the Board only, and it will not be shared with anyone else in the Association or any other person unless specifically directed by the person volunteering their information. This list is confidential to the HOA board and the webmaster only. See Slide D shows where this information is entered. After entering the information requested please hit the submit button at the bottom of the information you enter.

### **The HOA Information Page**

The purpose of the HOA Information Page is to update pertinent information about the HOA such as: The current year officers on the HOA Board and the ARB, (Architectural Review Board) for the current year calendar. **Please note**: that the officers are elected at the end of each year, at the HOA end year meeting. The information page also allows you to access all the information to the HOA, such as the Remittance Form to submit your HOA dues and all the pertinent documentation relative to the HOA such as the Declarations of Convenants, Maps of the development, the HOA Bylaws, and the ARB forms to submit in the event someone wants to upgrade the exterior of an existing home, or in building a new home within the development. Finally, this page has a "Button" link to the Neighborhood News page as an option if you prefer not to use the top and bottom page navigation links. See the Slides F thru J below.




