## Indianola Glass Creation's Paint Your Own Pottery

## Instructions

- 1) Please <u>WASH YOUR HANDS!</u> Any dirt, lotion or oil may cause the paint not to stick to the pottery.
- 2) After you have chosen your pottery piece, you may choose your paint. Only THREE (3) colors at a time and use small amounts as they tend to dry quickly. You can always go back for more. Leave all bottles on the shelf.
- 3) Remove the price tag and place on card with your name and phone number. You will show this card at the cash register to pay for the piece and return it to the table before leaving.
- 4) If you are painting a BANK, please remove the stopper before painting and take it home when you leave.
- 5) When you are ready to start painting, clean your piece with a damp sponge to remove any pottery dust.
- 6) Keep your brush loaded with plenty of paint. Apply THREE (3) coats of each color allowing the coat to dry before adding another one. If the coat is not dry before adding another coat, you will remove the previous coat.
- 7) Clean your brushes when changing colors and dab extra water out of them on the paper towel.
- 8) Any unpainted areas will be white.
- 9) When you are done, please leave used brushes in the water and things on the table including any stamps, stencils, writers or other tools you used. We will clean everything up for you! Please do not put used or dirty brushes, tools or writers back on the shelf.
