Without limiting the foregoing general purpose, the foundational purpose shall be to identify, develop and implement critical wraparound services for global social issues through advocacy and civic engagement. The organization is not organized for and shall not be operated for profit. In furtherance of its exempt purposes, the foundation may initiate, promote, and maintain activities on its own behalf, including but not limited to, sporting events for all communities, enrichment activities for underprivileged and underserved communities, religious revivals, educational and medical forums, events enriching cultural awareness, medical research and fundraising and advocacy against animal, child and elder abuse, sexual exploitation, human trafficking and gun violence. The foundation may also collaborate and contribute to other individuals, organizations and institutions for the purposes of its exempt status. The property of the corporation is irrevocably dedicated to its charitable, educational, scientific, literacy, religious, cultural, child and animal cruelty prevention, fostering of national and international amateur sports competition purposes and no part of the receipts, or net earnings of the corporation shall be used for any activities other than its mission.
