

## COVID-19 UPDATE FOR UPS MEMBERS AS OF THURSDAY, March 19, 2020 at 4:00 P.M.

UPS Members,

We have been working with UPS throughout the day, and below is a list of items we were able to accomplish for our members.

1. We were able to get members paid who have been required to self-isolate per a doctor's instruction. The payments are currently being processed.
2. We were able to get UPS cease all Ride-a-Longs with ALL drivers for all reasons, including annual rides, OJS and rides after an accident. The only exception is if there is a new driver in training.
3. Package car drivers will no longer have to hand DIADs over to customers.
4. UPS is not planning to subcontract, unless and only if drivers are out due to COVID-19. In the event UPS does subcontract, we are working on keeping all brokers out of the dispatch area, out of UPS buildings, and off of UPS property.
5. We met with UPS today and were able to get majority of the employees that were terminated returned back to work without having to arbitrate their cases.
6. Two weeks ago, Local 705 brought to Teamcare's attention the need to streamline the application process for disability due to COVID-19. After much discussion, Local 705 was successful in getting TeamCare to ease their disability application process.
