- Green - Lime (e.g., Lyme disease, non-Hodgkin lymphoma)
- Green (e.g., mental health, kidney cancer, climate change)
- Teal (e.g., ovarian cancer, anxiety, OCD, sexual assault)
- Blue - Light (e.g., prostate cancer, men's health)
- Blue (e.g., Parkinson's disease, brain injury)
- Blue - Dark (e.g., colorectal cancer)
- Purple (e.g., Alzheimer's disease, domestic violence, lupus, epilepsy, thyroid cancer, pancreatic cancer)
- Plum (e.g., caregiver)

- White (e.g., lung cancer, peace)
- Black (e.g., mourning, melanoma)
- Rainbow (e.g., pride)
- Puzzles (e.g., autism)
