

Shilp Guru L. Rathakrishnan

The outstanding Sculptor of the country Shri L. Rathakrishnan was born into a Viswakarma family of sculptors in 1947 at Tanjavur District. He started learning the noble art of sculptor making from the age of 14 at the Art Metal Centre at Swamimalai near Kumbakonam in Tanjavur. He was groomed by his National Award winning Guru Ramaswamy Sthapathi and specialised in Shilpashastra and Abhinayadarpana.

During 1987 he was appointed by Government of India to promote INDO - US cultural exchange at BOSTON Museum where he was adjudged the Master Artisan in statue making. He has trained more than 100 distinguished sculptors and thus preserved the sculptors heritage of India especially, the Lost Wax Method.

Between 1972 - 78 he lived in Malaysia and worked with a team of traditional artisans to create Temple sculptures there. He has created sculptures and Icons for temples across India, the US and Malaysia. Each piece created by him is a Masterpiece in the best tradition of the country's spirituality, bhakti and iconography.


Although a master of Pallava, Chola and Hoysala style bronze icons, Shri Rathakrishnan has brought in some North Indian elements into his sculptures.

He has participated in numerous prestigious exhibitions across India and conducted many workshops.

He has been responsible for forming SRUSHTI, The Tamilnadu Handicrafts Artisans Welfare Association for the upliftment of the traditional crafts. The SRUSHTI helps hundreds of artisan to showcase and sell their sculptures worldwide. These sculptures exhibit the pride of our Indian culture and heritage. In collaboration with the POOMPUKHAR,' Government of Tamilnadu Enterprise for promotion of handicrafts, he conducts a three year Vocational program in Bronze Sculpting. This program adopts the classical Indian 'Guru Kula' method of training for new generation of sculptors.


































































































Method of making solid image: Before coming to know the method of making icons, one must understand what is meant by wax. A mixture of Rosin powder and Bee-wax with gound-nutoil melted and filtered in cold water. Then it becomes solid. This is known as Wax. Then this wax is made flexible by keeping it near the fire and dipping it in hot water. Using this soft wax the image is formed by the artist in a rough sketch, but having the full details. This is called the wax-model.

Then this wax model is covered by a mixture of alluvial soil with water. Over this coating, a mixture of sand with clay and water is applied as second covering inserting some iron roads in order to strengthen the mould. During this process the runner portion of the image, at the base will be left without any coating. Then this mould what is familiarly known in Tamil "KARU" is exposed to sunlight for the complete removal of moisture. After the complete drying, it is encircled by iron wire in order to strengthen the mould. Then this mould is heated gradually from the bottom to top. During the process the wax inside the mould will come out through the runner slowly. The expelled wax is received in container which is used afterwards. Now inside the mould there will be a hollow image left blank Then this mould is heated to red-hot stage by burning fuels like wood-pieces dung cakes and charcoal. At the same time a mixture (copper, brass and lead) in the ratio of 10:2:1/10. is taken in a crucible which is ready in furnace with metal/molten. Then the red-hot mould is burnt in the earth, leaving the runner portion on the surface of the earth. Now the crucible is taken from the furnace using long pliers and the molten metal is poured into the mould through this runner to the full. After passing an hour the mould being cooled by pouring cold water, becomes solidified. Using hammer the soil coverings are removed and then we can see a rough sketch of metal image, which is chiseled, filled, and polished. After having carved out of the ornaments and dresses on the portions of the trunk and limbs of the image, the carvings on the face are worked out carefully. Then different colures are applied. Most of the foreigners like only the antique-dim and oxidized-black colures.

METHOD OF MAKING HOLLOW IMAGES

First of all the image is formed using the alluvial soil and jute-fibers with water. This clay model is made to dry and then it is encircled by thin iron wires. Then it is heated to the red-hotness. This is known as core. Then the soft wax is covered over the image to the thickness of 2 or 3 cms. Then some iron pins are inserted here and there over the mould horizontally in order to hold the core of the wax model. Then this image is formed in a rough sketch but having the full details by the artist. Now this is called wax model. Then this wax model is covered by two types of soil coating in order to make wax mould as already described. Now in between the two walls the wax model will be present as a thin layer. Then it is exposed to sunlight for drying. Afterwards the mould is heated bottom to top as explained already. Then the wax will come out through runner. After casting this mould we can see a rough sketch of metal image having the core inside.






