What is Leadership Barrow?

Leadership Barrow is an educational program that encourages and fosters the development of community leaders and volunteers by utilizing an interactive study program that inspires leadership.

The purpose of the program is to create a network of emerging leaders through an educational experience that increases the participants understanding of local institutions and community groups and how they serve this county.

By participating in Leadership Barrow, future leaders are more actively involved in community life and therefore better prepared to lead Barrow County to a brighter future.

Your time commitment:

Leadership Barrow consists of a two-day retreat, nine one-day sessions, a class project, group leadership project and graduation. The LB Program extends over an eleven month period (August thru June) and each participant must make a commitment to attend **all events and sessions**.

Additional Leadership Barrow Details:

Class members will work on leadership training each month as well as interact with community leaders in team building presentations, and visits to facilities in and around Barrow County and the State Capital. Listed below are some of the topics and assignments that are part of the program:

A weekday retreat, History of Barrow County, Educations/Barrow County School System, Non-Profits and their Role in the Community, Business & Leadership, State Government, Local Government, Public Services, Environment, Economic Development, Class Community Services Project, and Graduation.

Cost for Leadership Barrow:

Participants are charged tuition to defray the cost of program material, meals, retreat and graduation expenses, along with administrative costs. Cost for the entire program is \$1,000.

Each participant is responsible for paying his/her own tuition and/or for making arrangements for tuition to be paid by his/her employer or sponsoring organization before June 19th, 2024.

Space is limited. All applications received by deadline will be considered. Applicants will be notified by July 14th of acceptance into the program.
