- ■Departure from Kinshasa: In the morning, you will set off for the town of Moanda by car. The road will give you the opportunity to admire the magnificent landscape of Kongo Central.
- ■Pont bridge: On the road, you can take photos on the Pont (bridge) Maréchal/Matadi. The Matadi Bridge (ex. Maréchal) is a suspension bridge located on the road to Matadi. It crosses the Congo River and connects Matadi to Boma. Built in 1980, it will remain the longest suspension bridge on the African continent until 2018.
- ■Arrival in Moanda: Once you arrive in Moanda, you will be taken to one of the best hotels or guesthouses in town to settle in before enjoying a meal.
- ■Sunset: You will admire the sunset on the white sand beach around a campfire before going to bed

#### MVUADU: THE VILLAGE OF CRAFTSMEN


You will discover local crafts and learn more about the culture of the natives.

## DAY 5


- Departure from Moanda: In the afternoon, you will set off for the town of Boma.
- Arrival in Boma & City tour: Boma is the second most important city in Kongo Central, thanks to its port which is the second most important in the province. Having been an important city in the history of the DRC (capital from 1886 to 1929), Boma is the seat of important relics of history and a great witness to it. You can therefore visit:

#### STANLEY'S BAOBAB

■ Baobab in which the explorer Henry Morton Stanley would have stayed and having served as his camp after his arrival from Zanzibar in 1877.

#### THE FIRST MACHINES

You will be able to visit the first locomotive of the country and its first car which amazed the locals when they arrived

#### THE FIRST CATHEDRAL

■ Built on the mountain of the Holy Spirit, you can visit the first cathedral built in 1890.

#### The cost does not include:

- The visa: In order to access the territory of the DRC, a visa is required for certain coun tries, For more information, please contact the DRC Embassy in your country.
- Plane ticket
- Health and travel insurance
- Vaccine: Be sure to make an appointment with your doctor in order to have all the information about the vaccines to take for your trip to the DRC (ex. Yellow fever).
- All meals, drinks, and gratuities,
- and other things not included in this itinerary.





# Additional information

#### **Environmental Protection:**

Our company has a strong sustainability policy and we encourage our customers to follow basic environmental rules. Upon arrival, your guide will give you detailed information.

#### **Photography:**

It is allowed to take photos in DR Congo, but you must ask the opinion of your local guide. Exceptions are military personnel and property as well as public buildings. But do it with delicacy and dignity. Children always tend to appreciate photos.

#### Cash and change:

Kongo Tourisme staff can usually help you change currency during your trip. Exchange offices and banks are available in most major cities. Credit cards and travelers checks are generally not accepted in stores. However, ATMs dispense US dollars and Congolese Francs, especially in Kinshasa.

#### **Exit requirements:**

In addition to your stamped visa on entry, you will be required to pay an exit fee of 50 US dollars (called: Go Pass) at the airport when you leave the country.
