


## User Login

The following is the process to apply for a log-in:

Navigate to the website at <https://vizcayahoa.org/>

If you are not logged in and you try to navigate to any page other than this one from the menu items you will see



## Set Password

Create a password and hit Set Password. You will not have access until approval by the webmaster.

Please send an email to [webmaster@vizcayahoa.org](mailto:webmaster@vizcayahoa.org) in order to notify the webmaster there is a request pending for access to the website. In this email please indicate the **homeowner name**, **email address** and **residence address** for verification.

After the approval you will receive an email indicating you are granted access and can log in.

You can then go to [vizcayahoa.org](http://vizcayahoa.org) and sign in with your email and password you set up.

You will stay logged in on that device until you log out using the icon on the upper right side
