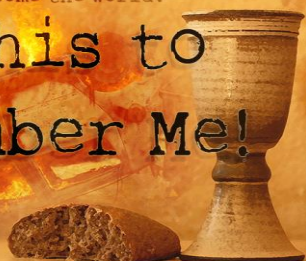
Communion Delivery
