

GUIDELINES AND QUALIFICATIONS

QUALIFICATIONS for our Camper in Leadership Training Program

1. Must be 15 years old or have finished 10th grade.
2. Must have had at least one week as a Cedarbrook camper. Exception: special recommendation of the Camp Director.
3. Must manifest the following traits of personality and character:
 - a. Know Christ as personal Savior
 - b. Exhibit a vital Christian testimony
 - c. Reflect good moral character
 - d. Demonstrate leadership ability
 - e. Assume responsibility
 - f. Work well as a group member
 - g. Show a willingness to learn
 - h. Be industrious, dependable, and adaptable
 - i. Be in good health and vitality
4. Must be interested in working with children.
5. Must receive recommendations from Youth Pastor or Director of Christian Education and one other adult who has observed the applicant in a position of leadership.



PROGRAM GUIDELINES:

1. The entire course takes two summers (two weeks each summer) and two weekends between the first and second years.
2. The CILT must serve as a junior counselor for an additional week in the second summer.
3. Attendance at PRE-CAMP Training is required prior to the second summer session.
4. The CILT pays the regular camp fees for two weeks each summer plus the weekend fees. Additional fees may be required for additional material.
5. CILTS will be evaluated at the end of the first summer and again at the spring weekend before continuing the program.
6. All course content work must be completed before graduation from program.
7. Completion of the CILT program does not guarantee a Cedarbrook Camp staff position.
