QUALIFICATIONS for our Camper in Leadership Training Program

- 1. Must be entering into high school.
- 2. Must manifest the following traits of personality and character:
 - a. Know Christ as personal Savior
 - b. Exhibit a vital Christian testimony
 - c. Reflect good moral character
 - d. Demonstrate leadership ability
 - e. Assume responsibility
 - f. Work well as a group member
 - g. Show a willingness to learn
 - h. Be industrious, dependable, and adaptable
 - i. Be in good health and vitality
- 3. Must be interested in working with children.
- 4. Must receive recommendations from Christian spiritual leaders in your life.

PROGRAM GUIDELINES:

- 1. The entire course can be completed over a number of summers and digital meetings, as well as a special CILT weekend at camp.
- 2. The CILT must serve as a junior counselor at camp.
- 3. PRE-CAMP Training is required prior to serving as as junior counselor.
- 4. The CILT pays the regular camp fees for their week at camp as well as an additional fee for the CILT weekend.
- 5. All course content work must be completed before graduation from program.
- 6. Completion of the CILT program does not guarantee a Cedarbrook Camp staff position.
