## ONE NATION UNDER GOD



On this important day, the 4th of July, on which we celebrate our independence, I am on vacation visiting my mother and family in the land where I was born. I'm Colombian by birth but American by heart. I will miss being here and sharing my great and wonderful American family with you. I will pray for you and this great country: the *UNITED STATES OF AMERICA*.

I found a beautiful prayer for the nation composed by George Washington, the father of this country. The prayer was part of a short letter he wrote in Newburgh, New York, at the close of the Revolutionary War on June 14, 1783. Washington sent it to the thirteen governors of the newly freed states that same date.

Reading it, I realized how important God, our Creator, Lord of Lords, King of Kings, has been for our nation since its origins. The first sentence is a great declaration about who God is (Almighty), then there is a petition of protection for unity, obedience, and the spirit of brotherhood. To ask God for justice, charity, humility, and to love mercy is the key to having the hope of being a happy nation. For me, this is a beautiful prayer that helps us understand our role as faithful and good citizens of this nation living according to the teachings of Jesus Christ, who taught us how to live in this world loving one another as we love ourselves.

Let us pray together: *Almighty GOD, we make our earnest prayer that Thou wilt keep the United States in Thy holy protection; that thou wilt incline the hearts of the citizens to cultivate a spirit of subordination and obedience to government, and entertain a brotherly affection and love for one another and their fellow citizens of the United States of America at large. And finally that Thou wilt most graciously be pleased to dispose us all to do justice, to love mercy and to demean ourselves with that charity, humility and pacific temper of mind which were the characteristics of The Divine Author of our blessed religion without a humble imitation of whose example in these things we can never hope to be a happy nation. Grant our supplication, we beseech thee, through Jesus Christ, Our Lord. Amen.*

## CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS — WHAT, WHO, AND WHEN



**RCIA**  
*A Journey In Faith*

Over the next several weeks, we will offer an overview of the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (formerly RCIA). We hope these articles will provide you with a resource and roadmap for yourself or others you invite to join us in the universal Church on how to join us in full communion.

### What are the Steps of Christian Initiation?

Before beginning the process of becoming a Christian, an individual comes to some knowledge of Jesus Christ, considers their relationship with Jesus Christ, and is usually attracted in some way to the Catholic Church. This period is known as the Period of Evangelization and Precatechumenate. For some, this process involves a long period of searching; for others, a shorter time. Contact with people of faith and a personal faith experience often lead people to inquire about the Catholic Church. After a conversation with a priest or a parish director of Christian Initiation, the person, known as an "inquirer," may seek acceptance into the Order of Catechumens through the Rite of Acceptance. During this Rite, the inquirer stands amidst the parish community and states that they want to become a baptized member of the Catholic Church. The parish assembly affirms this desire and the inquirer becomes a Catechumen.

## SAINT OF THE WEEK: MARIA GORETTI



One of the largest crowds ever assembled for a canonization—250,000—symbolized the reaction of millions touched by the simple story of Maria Goretti. She was the daughter of a poor Italian tenant farmer, had no chance to go to school, and never learned to read or write. When Maria made her First Communion not long before her death, she was one of the class's larger and somewhat backward members.

On a hot afternoon in July, Maria was sitting at the top of the stairs of her house, mending a shirt. She was not quite 12 years old but physically mature. A cart stopped outside, and a neighbor, 18-year-old Alessandro, ran up the stairs. He seized her and pulled her into a bedroom. She struggled and tried to call for help. "No, God does not wish it," she cried out. "It is a sin. You would go to hell for it." Alessandro began striking at her blindly with a long dagger.

Maria was taken to a hospital. Her last hours were marked by the usual simple compassion of the good—concern about where her mother would sleep, the forgiveness of her murderer (she had been in fear of him but did not say anything lest she causes trouble to his family), and her devout welcoming of Viaticum, her last Holy Communion. She died about 24 hours after the attack.

Alessandro was sentenced to 30 years in prison. For a long time, he was unrepentant and surly. One night he had a dream or vision of Maria gathering flowers and offering them to him. His life changed. When he was released after 27 years, his first act was to beg the forgiveness of Maria's mother.

Devotion to the young martyr grew, miracles were worked, and she was canonized in less than half a century. At her beatification in 1947, her 82-year-old mother, two sisters, and her brother appeared with Pope Pius XII on the balcony of St. Peter's. Three years later, at Maria's canonization, a 66-year-old Alessandro Serenelli knelt among the quarter-million people and cried tears of joy.

### Reflection:

Maria may have had trouble with the catechism but had no problem with faith. God's will was holiness, decency, respect for one's body, absolute obedience, and total trust. In a complex world, her faith was simple: It is a privilege to be loved by God and love him—at any cost.
