

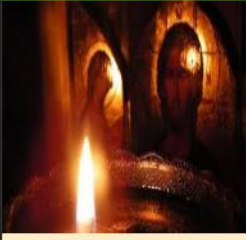

CONFIDENT IN THE DIVINE PROVIDENCE



The call from Jesus is well-known as a vocation. He has called all of us with a purpose and a mission that we must accomplish. In today's Gospel, after Jesus chose his disciples and instructed them, he sent them on a special mission. His instructions were very clear about what to do, what they would bring, and what they needed for their mission.

It's fascinating how the Lord strengthened their faith through his teachings and miracles while preparing his disciples for their first mission. In other words, He took time to prepare and nourish them spiritually. Afterward, he sent them out as missionaries to preach to others. Their mission was not just to spread a message but to be witnesses of Jesus' love and mercy. As Thomas Aquinas said: "Contemplare et contemplata allis tradere," which means, "Contemplate and to bring others the fruits of our contemplation."

The contemplation of the life and works of Jesus makes us witnesses of his love and mercy. We can bring consolation and comfort to our brothers and sisters who need to hear a word that gives them courage. As followers of the Lord, we know where our strength lies: Only in the Lord.

Through our own relationship with the Lord, he does not just send us; we are chosen to share the good news of salvation with the world. This mission "ad intra" becomes the foundation for "mission ad extra." This simply means building our faith in Christ and living a holy life in Him. It also means developing a missionary spirit to help others encounter Christ.

To ensure his disciples' success and to keep them focused on their purpose, Christ not only instructed them on how to go about their mission, but he also reassured them of his constant presence and support. The world may present many distractions and comforts that make it risky for missionaries to lose focus on the real mission of Christ. But Jesus told them they needed nothing material to succeed in missionary work. He will be with us, sponsoring our assignment, and in his hand, we will find the provisions we need for our survival.

As missionaries, we must walk confidently in God's providence and share the joy of freedom from God.

SAINT OF THE WEEK: CHARBEL MAKHLOUF



St. Charbel Makhlouf, a Maronite Catholic priest, monk, and hermit who is known for working miracles both during his life and after his death. On the occasion of his beatification in 1965, the Eastern Catholic hermit was described by Pope Paul VI as “a new, eminent member of monastic sanctity,” who “through his example and his intercession is enriching the entire Christian people.”

Born into humble circumstances in Lebanon in 1828, Youssef Antoun Makhlouf was the youngest of Antoun Zaarour Makhlouf and Brigitta Elias al-Shediyaq’s five children. Antoun, who had been taken away from the family and forced into hard labor, died when his youngest son was only three.

Yussef studied at the parish school and tended to his family’s cow. Engaged in prayer and solitude from an early age, he spent a great deal of time outdoors in the fields and pastures near his village, contemplating God amid the inspiring views of Lebanon’s valleys and mountains. His uncle and guardian Tanious wanted the boy to continue working with him, while his mother wanted him to marry a young woman. Yussef had other plans, however, and left home in 1851 without informing anyone.

Yussef would become “Brother Charbel” after making a pilgrimage on foot to his new monastic home. In this, he followed the example of his maternal uncles, who were already living as solitary monks at the Hermitage of St. Paul in the Qadisha Valley.

Charbel took his monastic vows in November of 1853 during a solemn ceremony closed to the public and off-limits even to his family. He subsequently studied for the priesthood and was ordained, returning to the Monastery of St. Maron.

The priest-monk lived and served in the monastery for 19 years, showing great devotion to the life of prayer, manual work, and contemplative silence.

Charbel’s superiors observed God’s “supernatural power” at work in his life, and he became known as a wonder-worker even among some Muslims. In 1875, he was granted permission to live as a solitary monk in a nearby hermitage dedicated to Sts. Peter and Paul. Rigorous asceticism and a profound union with God characterized the monk’s life for the next 23 years. Deeply devoted to God’s Eucharistic presence, he suffered a stroke while celebrating the Divine Liturgy of the Maronite Catholic Church on December 16, 1898. He died on Christmas Eve of that year.

St. Charbel’s tomb has been a site for pilgrimages since his death. Hundreds of miracles are believed to have occurred through his intercession with God, both in Lebanon and around the world. He was canonized in 1977 by Pope Paul VI, who had earlier hailed the Lebanese Maronite saint as an “admirable flower of sanctity blooming on the stem of the ancient monastic traditions of the East.”

HOW DO WE KNOW THE EUCHARIST IS JESUS’ BODY AND BLOOD?

Our eyes will likely never see the bread and wine change into Jesus' body and blood. Ultimately, belief in the Eucharist requires trust in God.

In our scientific world, we often want everything verified and calculated, telling us exactly how something happens or being able to see the mechanisms unfold before our eyes. Unfortunately, outside of a few Eucharistic miracles, there are no visible changes to the bread and wine we see at Mass.

Even if we put a normal consecrated host under a microscope, we would not see it transformed into Jesus' body and blood. Our physical eyes will likely never distinguish between consecrated and unconsecrated hosts.

How can we be certain?

Belief in the Eucharist boils down to trust in God.

The *Catechism of the Catholic Church* explains this in its section on the Eucharist: "That in this sacrament are the true Body of Christ, and his true Blood is something that '**cannot be apprehended by the senses**,' says St. Thomas, 'but **only by faith**, which relies on divine authority.' For this reason, in a commentary on Luke 22:19 ('This is my body which is given for you.'). St. Cyril says: 'Do not doubt whether this is true, but rather receive the words of the Savior in faith, for **since he is the truth, he cannot lie.**'" CCC 1381

If we believe that Jesus is God and that he told the truth while on earth, then we are challenged to believe in the gift of the Eucharist and that he is able to miraculously transform bread and wine into his body, blood, soul, and divinity.

The *Catechism* provides a few verses from St. Thomas' hymn *Adoro te devote* as an example of the type of faith we should have:

Godhead here in hiding, whom I do adore
Masked by these bare shadows, shape and nothing more,
See, Lord, at thy service low lies here a heart.
Lost, all lost in wonder at the God thou art.

Seeing, touching, tasting are in thee deceived;
How says trusty hearing? That shall be believed;
What God's Son has told me, take for truth I do;
Truth himself speaks truly, or there's nothing true.
CCC 1381

When it comes to the Eucharist, we need both faith and reason. We cannot believe in the Eucharist through reason alone. **It all comes down to faith and trusting that God did not lie to us but is truly present in a unique and miraculous way.**



CONFIDENTE EN LA DIVINA PROVIDENCIA

Como dijo Tomás de Aquino: “Contemplare et contemplata allis tradere”, que significa “contemplar y llevar a otros los frutos de nuestra contemplación”.

La contemplación de la vida y obra de Jesús nos hace testigos de su amor y misericordia. Podemos llevar consuelo y esperanza a nuestros hermanos y hermanas que necesitan escuchar una palabra que les dé valor. Como seguidores del Señor, sabemos dónde reside nuestra fuerza: sólo en el Señor.

A través de nuestra propia relación con el Señor, él no sólo nos envía; somos elegidos para compartir las buenas nuevas de salvación con el mundo. Esta misión “ad intra” se convierte en el fundamento de la “misión ad extra”. Esto simplemente significa edificar nuestra fe en Cristo y vivir una vida santa en Él. También significa desarrollar un espíritu misionero para ayudar a otros a encontrar a Cristo.

Para asegurar el éxito de sus discípulos y mantenerlos enfocados en su propósito, Cristo no solo les instruyó sobre cómo llevar a cabo su misión, sino que también les aseguró su constante presencia y apoyo. El mundo puede presentar muchas distracciones y comodidades que hacen que sea riesgoso para los misioneros perder el enfoque en la verdadera misión de Cristo. Pero Jesús les dijo que no necesitaban nada material para tener éxito en la obra misional. Él estará con nosotros, patrocinando nuestra misión, y en su mano encontraremos las provisiones que necesitamos para nuestra supervivencia.

Como misioneros, debemos caminar con confianza en la providencia de Dios y compartir el gozo de la libertad de Dios.
