



Day 1: Wednesday, May 10, 2023 Overnight Flight Travel to the Holy Land on an inspirational journey that visits some of the most ancient sites in the world.

Day 2: Thursday, May 11, 2023 Tel Aviv, Israel - Tour Begins Your tour begins in Tel Aviv, a bustling city brimming with culture and history, situated on the Israeli Mediterranean coastline. Tonight, join your fellow travelers for a dinner at your hotel. (*D*)


Day 3: Friday, May 12, 2023 Tel Aviv - Caesarea - Mount Tabor - Cana - Tiberias Travel to the walled city and Roman ruins of Caesarea. It was here that St. Peter converted the first pagan, Centurion Cornelius, to become a Christian, and where St. Paul was imprisoned for two years. Travel to Mount Tabor, the site of Our Lord's Transfiguration. Your day continues with a visit to Cana, the site of Jesus' first miracle, at a wedding feast. Celebrate Mass at the Church of the First Miracle, where you can opt to renew your marriage vows.* Arrive in Tiberias for a 2-night stay. (*B*, *D*)

Day 4: Saturday, May 13, 2023 Tiberias - Sea of Galilee -Tabgha - Capernaum - Tiberias This morning, travel to nearby Tabgha and visit the Church of the Multiplication of the Loaves and the Fishes, built to commemorate the miraculous feeding of five thousand. Stop at the Mount of Beatitudes for a stunning view of the Sea of Galilee. Celebrate Mass at the Church of the Beatitudes. Continue to the Church of the Primacy of St. Peter, where Our Lord appeared to the apostles after His resurrection. In Capernaum, visit the church built over the ruins of St. Peter's house. Finally, visit Yardenit, the Jordan River baptismal site where you may opt to renew your baptismal vows.** Later this afternoon, take a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee, where many of the Apostles were fishermen and where Our Lord preached. Relax over dinner at a local restaurant featuring traditional Middle Eastern cuisine such as assorted appetizers and grilled meats. (B, D)

Day 5: Sunday, May 14, 2023 Tiberias - Nazareth - Bethlehem - Jerusalem In Nazareth, visit the Church of the Annunciation. Proceed to Bethlehem and enjoy a stop at Shepherds' Field, where the Angels appeared on the first Christmas night. Celebrate Mass at the Church of the Nativity, built on the birth site of Our Lord.*** Later, arrive in one of the holiest cities in the world, Jerusalem. (B, D)

Day 6: Monday, May 15, 2023 Jerusalem - Garden of Gethsemane Your visit to Jerusalem begins with a stop at the Church of the Pater Noster ("Our Father"), built on the traditional site where Jesus taught His disciples the Lord's Prayer. Next, make your way down the steep descent of the Palm Sunday route to the site where Our Lord wept over the city, now known as Dominus Flevit. Afterwards, reflect at the Church of All Nations, built over the rock on which Our Lord prayed the night before He was crucified. Visit the Garden of Gethsemane, the site of Christ's betrayal by Judas. Next, visit the Church of the Dormition (commemorating Our Lady's Assumption) and the nearby Hall of the Last Supper. Pause at Caiaphas' Palace – known today as St. Peter in Gallicantu – where St. Peter once denied Our Lord in one of its courts. This afternoon, travel to Ein Karem to visit the Church of St. John

the Baptist, built over the Grotto of his birthplace, and celebrate Mass. (B, D)

Day 7: Tuesday, May 16, 2023 Jerusalem The day is yours to explore the city on your own. Perhaps you'll choose to take an optional excursion to Jericho, Bethany and the Dead Sea. No matter how you spend your day, gather in the evening with your fellow travelers to celebrate Mass. (*B, D*)

Day 8: Wednesday, May 17, 2023 Jerusalem, the Old City Follow in the footsteps of Our Lord today as you visit the Church of St. Anne, marking the place where the parents of the Blessed Mother lived. Pause for a moment of devotion close to St. Stephen's Gate, where the first Christian martyr was stoned to death. Continue to the nearby Pools of Bethesda, where Jesus healed the paralytic, and see the Ecce Homo Arch, the

site where Pontius Pilate presented Our Lord to the crowds. Walk through the Muslim, Christian and Jewish quarters to the Western Wall of the Temple. Then, follow the Via Dolorosa, the Way of the Cross, walked by Our Lord on the way to His crucifixion. Celebrate Mass at the Church of the Holy Sepulchre, the site of His crucifixion, burial and resurrection. Enjoy an afternoon at leisure in Jerusalem, before celebrating the end of this unforgettable and holy experience at a farewell dinner in a local restaurant**** that features ingredients inspired from the Bible. (*B*, *D*)

Day 9: Thursday, May 18, 2023 Jerusalem - Tour Ends Your tour comes to a close today, leaving you with many pleasant memories. (*B*)

In addition to Israel, this tour travels through the occupied Palestinian territory of the West Bank.

The overall activity level of this tour is a level 3. This means you're an onthe-go traveler. You don't want to miss a thing, so to fully experience this itinerary, you must be able to walk unassisted for 2.5 miles and stand at least 15-60 minutes at a time with no opportunity to sit down. You can navigate hills and uneven ground, climb into various modes of transportation (tuk-tuk, cable car, Zodiac, etc.), and could possibly anticipate changes in elevation. In particular, while touring in Jerusalem, you will be required to walk over cobblestones and up/down steep roads for an extended amount of time. You can expect some longer days balanced with free-time to recharge or set out on your own adventure. In this destination, temperatures may exceed over 100° F (37° C) with high levels of humidity, especially while in Tel Aviv, Caesarea and Tiberias. You should bring adequate sun protection and be prepared to walk and stand in the heat with limited to no shade.



Proper dress is required when visiting religious sites, sanctuaries, basilicas, etc.

All meals taking place at the hotels in Tel Aviv, Tiberias and Jerusalem are served buffet-style, including dinners.

****The day of the dinner in local restaurant may differ due to local holidays and religious observances. In some rare instances, when your tour falls over the Jewish High Holidays, the dinner in local restaurant may have to be replaced by an additional meal at the hotel.

Due to flight schedules, you may require a very early morning departure from the hotel on your last day. Travel distance from Jerusalem to Tel Aviv's Ben Gurion Airport is approximately 1.5 hours (depending upon traffic conditions). Due to security checkpoints, it is recommended that you arrive at Ben Gurion Airport 3 hours prior to departure.

Discover the treasures of Jerusalem by night, a beacon of three faiths. By bus, enjoy stunning views of the Old City walls, Temple Mount and Mount Zion. On foot, walk through Jaffa gate to the Old City (UNESCO), which combines ancient beauty with timeless allure, and visit the Citadel (also known as the Tower of David). The Judean Wilderness: Jericho & the Dead Sea

Explore the Judean Wilderness today. Spend time in the desert where Jesus endured 40 days of fasting after being baptized by Saint John the Baptist. Visit Jericho, the oldest city on earth. View Elisha's Spring and the Mount of Temptations, where Satan tried to tempt Jesus 3 times. Travel to Qumran for a view of the caves where the Dead Sea Scrolls were found. Then journey to the Dead Sea, the site of the ancient Sodom and Gomorrah. At 1,288 feet below sea level, it is the lowest point on earth. Day 9: Jerusalem - Border Crossing - Madaba, Jordan - Mt. Nebo - Petra

Visit the Church of St. George to see the famous 6th-century Byzantine mosaic map of the region, one of the oldest in existence, and the museum where many other spectacular mosaic examples are on display. You will also visit Mt. Nebo, where Moses saw the Promised Land – present day Israel – and is believed to be laid to rest. Continue to the ancient city of Petra for a 2-night stay. Enjoy a full day tour of the remarkable stone-carved city of Petra (UNESCO), one of the new Wonders of the World. A treasure of the ancient world, Petra was "hidden" behind rugged mountains prior to its discovery in 1812 after being lost for over 500 years. Explore this breathtaking city, carved from sandstone by the Nabataeans, with an expert guide and learn about the importance of Petra to the ancient trade routes, the history of its prominence and decline, its rediscovery, and efforts at preservation. *Today breakfast will be included*.

When using the shuttle buses at the border crossings, a 3 US Dollar fee per person, paid in local currency or US Dollars, is collected on the bus by each driver. A Jordanian entrance visa is arranged by our local Jordanian agent in advance. The Jordan exit fee is approximately 15 US Dollars per person, paid in local currency. Rates are approximate and can be changed at any time without notice, based on governing authority. Money can be exchanged at the border crossing. The border crossing is mandated by the government and may have unpredictable wait times and longer lines. This process is similar to security and customs at an international airport. Due to security regulations, your guide cannot assist you in the border crossing. You will be responsible for handling your luggage from the bus drop-off point (on the Israeli side) to the bus pick-up point (on the Jordanian side). With your luggage, you will take the shuttle bus from the Israeli Terminal to the Jordanian Terminal located 3 miles away, where your Jordanian guide will meet you.
