

TAKE A RISK! BE BRAVE!



This Sunday, we reflect on the parable of talents and gifts that God has given us according to our capacity. We have been created with many skills; we cannot say that we are useless because we have not received anything from our Creator. Our vocation as Catholics is to produce abundant fruits of salvation that, at least, duplicate the blessings that we have received from God. But we cannot be happy only duplicating our gifts; we are called to multiply them and to be an active part of the Kingdom of God since we arrived in this world. God is not asking for impossible things. He expects to see that what is a blessing from Him in this present life gives fruits and is being shared with others by the good and perfect discipleship in which we must be very active.

What is the biggest enemy of a fruitful life? What is the main difficulty that we face when we want to be good servants of the Lord? I think the answer is the parable of the man who received a talent buried in the ground. "I was afraid -he says- and I went and hid your talent in the ground. Here you have what is yours" (Mt.25:25). He was not a bad guy, but he acted as "wicked and lazy," which disappointed the Master, who raged at his lack of action. He did not squander or make improper use of the talent he received, but he was afraid, and his evil was that of failing to do good. He thought that he was a good steward, but his fear and his lack of enthusiasm made him a flawed and indifferent servant.

Sometimes, we think that we haven't done anything wrong, so we rest contently, presuming that we are good and just. But in this way, we risk acting like the unworthy servant. He did no wrong; he didn't waste the talent. In fact, he kept it carefully hidden in the ground. But, to do no wrong is not enough. It is very sad when our Heavenly Father does not receive a good and generous response of love from his children.

The parable exalts the one who adds new talents, and he is called "faithful" because he takes a risk to love and do things trying to please his Master. In our relationship with Jesus, we need to be brave, knowing that when we do good and bear fruit, we can risk many personal things, or sometimes we die to our own desires and pretenses, but the most important thing is that we are pleasing God.

We cannot say that we have not received talents and have nothing to do or share with others. God has blessed us, and we cannot allow our own fears to make us lazy and procrastinate the good work that we are called to do as real disciples of the Lord.

ST. OF THE WEEK: ST. ELIZABETH OF HUNGARY



Of Hungarian royal birth, Elizabeth grew up at the court of Thuringia, in Germany, where she married the kindly Ludwig when she was but fourteen. Her piety and preference for the poor drew the ire of the courtiers, but Elizabeth's desire to follow Christ did not waver. After Ludwig's unexpected death in 1227, Elizabeth modeled her life on that of St. Francis of Assisi. She founded a hospital

at Marburg, where she personally tended the sick and the dying. When her spiritual director questioned her, she told him that she "received from the poor special grace and humility." Elizabeth died in 1231. She was twenty-four.

What is happening next Sunday at Mass for those ready to move forward in our parish's RCIA process? The initial inquiry (precatechumenate) period for our parish's group of inquirers will be moving into the second stage, with our first opportunity for unbaptized inquirers to go through the Rite of Acceptance into the Order of Catechumens. The first phase of the journey of initiation has been a time for seekers to hear the mystery of Christ proclaimed. The inquirers have consciously and freely sought the living God and entered the way of faith and conversion as the Holy Spirit opens their hearts. We ask you to please pray for the inquirers as they continue their conversion journey and for our RCIA process as we assist them in moving toward a closer relationship with God. Your prayers are critical to the success of our program. We will continue to keep you informed of the initiation process and progress of those considering joining the Church. We invite you to take an active role in welcoming our soon-to-be catechumens, and to be models of faith and Christian charity for them.

COMMEMORATED NAMES DURING THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER



No desperdició, ni hizo un uso indebido del talento que recibió, pero tuvo miedo, y su error fue no hacer el bien. Pensaba que era un buen mayordomo, pero su miedo y su falta de entusiasmo lo convertían en un sirviente imperfecto e indiferente.

La parábola exalta al que agrega nuevos talentos, y se le llama "fiel" porque se arriesga a amar y hacer las cosas tratando de agradar a su Maestro. En nuestra relación con Jesús, debemos ser valientes, sabiendo que cuando hacemos el bien y damos frutos, podemos arriesgar muchas cosas personales, o en ocasiones morirnos a nuestros propios deseos y pretensiones, pero lo más importante es que estamos complaciendo a Dios.

No podemos decir que no hemos recibido talentos y no tenemos nada que hacer o compartir con los demás. Dios nos ha bendecido y no podemos permitir que nuestros propios miedos nos vuelvan perezosos y posterguen la buena obra que estamos llamados a hacer como verdaderos discípulos del Señor.
