ONE GOD IN THREE PERSONS



This Sunday, we are celebrating the mystery of the Holy Trinity. As people of faith, we are called to receive this great mystery as a gift, to understand what the theologians, doctors of the church, and saints have said about the Holy Trinity after prayer, studies, contemplation, and their love for God the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. This knowledge and holiness of our ancestors in faith will help us to grow in our faith and feel in our hearts that even though it is a mystery, we can have an approach through our personal prayer and contemplation.

I want to start this simple explanation about the Holy Trinity with the basic concept that I know all of us have heard since we, as Catholics, can remember: God exists as three persons but is one being with one divine nature. The Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit are equals. The Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit are adored and glorified. They are, and co-Eternals (have existed forever). They participate in the same nature (consubstantial with the Father). The Son of God was born of the Father before all ages. The Holy Spirit, who is the love between the Father and the Son, affirmed in the Creed (the Holy Spirit proceeds from the Father and the Son).

The Father is uncreated, the Son is uncreated, and the Holy Spirit is uncreated, and all three are eternal without beginning. Being three different persons is one God. Their names, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit are never different parts of God, He is only one, and these three persons cannot be separate from one another; they participate of the same nature. The meaning of "Trinity" explains the three parts of the same God and how they form the whole God. Tri-Unity is the unity of three persons that conform to one and unique God. Some use math to explain the Holy Trinity. We cannot think of the Holy Trinity as a sum of three parts (I + I + I = 3), but instead, show how each part multiplies the others to form a wonderful whole $(I \times I \times I = I)$. Using the multiplication model, we show that the three form a union.

I hope that this simple approach to the mystery of the Holy Trinity is helpful to proclaim with more faith and enthusiasm our love for the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit.

TRINITY SUNDAY: MAY 30, 2021



Trinity Sunday celebrates the Christian doctrine of the Trinity, the three Persons of God: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.

The fundamental dogma on which everything in Christianity is based is that of the Blessed Trinity, in whose name all Christians are baptized. The feast of the Blessed Trinity needs to be understood and celebrated as a prolongation of the mysteries of Christ and as the solemn expression of our faith in this triune life of the Divine Persons, to which we have been given access by Baptism and by the Redemption won for us by Christ. Only in heaven shall we properly understand what it means, in union with Christ, to share as sons in the very life of God.

The feast of the Blessed Trinity was introduced in the ninth century and was only inserted in the general calendar of the Church in the fourteenth century by Pope John XXII. But the cultus of the Trinity is, of course, to be found

throughout the liturgy. Constantly, the Church causes us to praise and adore the thrice-holy God who has shown His mercy towards us and has given us to share in His life.

Before Mass: Ushers greet and welcome Mass attendees at the church entrance

ways. They serve as representatives of the church, and therefore their demeanor and body language should reflect its hospitality. They take note of any known doctors or nurses in attendance, should anyone need medical assistance during the Mass. Also, they assist attendees as needed with finding a seat, paying particular attention to those with special needs. During crowded services, assisting with seating is especially important.

During Mass: Ushers sit at the back of the church and participate fully in the service. When late-comers arrive, ushers help minimize disruptions by asking them to momentarily stand by during the readings and the priest's homily. Ushers are also responsible for passing around the collection baskets. During communion, they assist the Eucharistic Ministers by pointing out those who cannot proceed through the communion line and therefore need communion.

SAINT OF THE WEEK: ST. RAFAEL GUIZAR



Rafael was one of eleven children born to ardent Catholic landowners in Cotija, Michoacan, Mexico. He studied for the priesthood and, after his ordination in 1901, pursued missionary work in Zamora and directed the seminary there.

In 1911, Rafael founded a religious newspaper to combat the repression of the Church by the Mexican government. The paper was soon shut down, and Rafael became a wanted man, forced to travel constantly in disguise. He posed variously as a street vendor, a musician, and a doctor of homeopathy—in this last disguise, he was best able to minister to the sick and the dying. At last, Rafael was forced to escape to the United States. He then turned again to missionary work in Guatemala and Cuba.

In 1919, Rafael learned that he had been elected Bishop of Veracruz, Mexico, and he returned to his homeland the following January. For two years, he undertook a visitation of his extensive diocese. He founded a clandestine seminary for the education of priests, and when violent earthquakes hit the region, he worked tirelessly for those who were suffering from the destruction. He would become known as "bishop of the poor."

Nine of Rafael's eighteen years as a bishop were spent in exile or in hiding. He died in 1938, after six months of leading his diocese from his sickbed. Magnificat: May 2021

UN DIOS EN TRES PERSONAS

Este domingo celebramos el misterio de la Santísima Trinidad. Como personas de fe, estamos llamados a recibir este gran misterio como un don, a comprender lo que los teólogos, los doctores de la Iglesia y los santos han dicho sobre la Santísima Trinidad después de la oración, los estudios, la contemplación y su amor a Dios Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo. Este conocimiento y santidad de nuestros antepasados en la fe nos ayudará a crecer en nuestra fe y sentir en nuestro corazón que, aunque es un misterio, podemos acercarnos a través de nuestra oración y contemplación personal.

Quiero comenzar esta explicación simple sobre la Santísima Trinidad con el concepto básico que sé que todos hemos escuchado desde que nosotros, como católicos, podemos recordar: Dios existe como tres personas pero es un ser con una naturaleza divina. El Padre, el Hijo y el Espíritu Santo son iguales. El Padre, el Hijo y el Espíritu Santo son adorados y glorificados. Son co-Eternos (han existido desde siempre). Participan de la misma naturaleza (consustancial con el Padre). El Hijo de Dios nació del Padre antes de todas las edades. El Espíritu Santo, que es el amor entre el Padre y el Hijo, afirmado en el Credo (el Espíritu Santo procede del Padre y del Hijo).

El Padre es increado, el Hijo es increado y el Espiritu Santo es increado, y los tres son eternos sin principio. Ser tres personas distintas y un solo Dios. Sus nombres, Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo nunca son partes diferentes de Dios, Él es solo uno, y estas tres personas no pueden estar separadas entre sí; participan de la misma naturaleza. El significado de "Trinidad" explica las tres partes del mismo Dios y cómo forman el Dios completo. Tri-Unidad es la unidad de tres personas que conforman a un Dios único. Algunos usan las matemáticas para explicar la Santísima Trinidad. No podemos pensar en la Santísima Trinidad como una suma de tres partes (1 + 1 + 1 = 3), sino mostrar cómo cada parte multiplica a las demás para formar un todo maravilloso $(1 \times 1 \times 1 = 1)$. Usando el modelo de multiplicación, mostramos que los tres forman una unión.

Espero que este sencillo acercamiento al misterio de la Santísima Trinidad sea útil para proclamar con más fe y entusiasmo nuestro amor por el Padre y el Hijo y el Espíritu Santo.
