LET US CROSS TO THE OTHER SIDE



After imparting his teachings on faith, Jesus invited the disciples to go to the other shore of the Lake of Galilee (Mk 4:35), where they will find themselves in the territory of pagans. In his teachings to the crowd, Jesus showed that faith grows as a gift from God, and nothing can prevent it. To face the pagan land, the disciples of the Lord were called to strengthen and reaffirm themselves in their trust in God, who has dominion over all history. No power will prevail over the One who has created everything. In this Sunday's Gospel (Mk 4:35-41), we see the dominion of Jesus over the waters, and in this, all the signs that ratify his Lordship are inaugurated.

The storm at sea reminds us of the realities that we are called to overcome in faith. For this reason, these waters are crossed in the boat, which signifies the Church whose mission is to bear witness to the Word that Jesus has communicated to her and in the midst of which we receive the grace offered

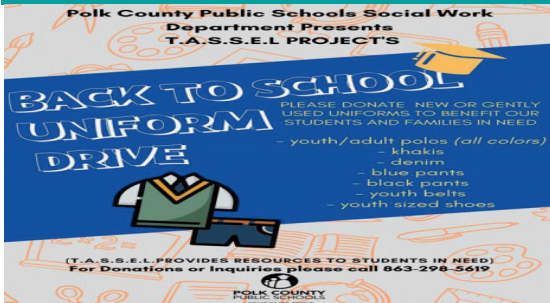
by the sacraments. In these sacraments, the Lord continues to deliver us from the influence of the destroyers who want to confuse the hearts of their disciples.

The dominion of Jesus over the waters is also a messianic symbol since it recalls the signs manifested in the Old Testament to accompany the authority of Moses and Elijah. They, obeying the voice of God, were able to calm the waters so that the chosen people could cross them safely. To cross this world supported by the presence of the Messiah who remains in the boat so that we can reach Eternal Life, let us surrender to his voice so that his glory is manifested in our works and all terror is far from our lives.

To cross to the other side, we are never alone; Jesus is always with us. This is great news!

SAINT OF THE WEEK: ST. SERAPION THE SCHOLASTIC



Serapion was an Egyptian monk who rose to become the head of the catechetical school of Alexandria in Egypt. After a time, a desire for solitude overtook him, and he retired to the desert, where he sought the guidance of Saint Anthony the Great. When Serapion was made Bishop of Thmuis on the Nile Delta, he found himself at the center of the violent Arian heresy. Serapion sided with the great bulwark of orthodoxy in East, Saint Athanasius, and was summarily exiled by the emperor.

Among Serapion's written works are the letters he addressed to Athanasius in an attempt to craft a response to those who denied the divinity of the Holy Spirit. Also attributed to Serapion is an early sacramentary containing thirty prayers for Mass, ordination, baptism, burial, and the blessing of oil, bread, and water. This sacramentary contains the first-ever recorded use of the Sanctus in the liturgy.

Serapion lived by a simple rule that he willingly taught to others: "The mind is purified by spiritual knowledge (or by holy meditation and prayer), the spiritual passions of the soul by charity, and the irregular appetites by abstinence and penance."

Will she not advocate our cause before the tribunal of divine mercy? Will she not incessantly doubt it? If she has not permitted those who could no longer live to pass from this life, even requiring a dispensation of the laws of nature to recall those who were almost dead, that they might not perish eternally, merely because they had preserved some shadow of devotion and had placed some confidence in her protection—if she has done even this, will she permit the truly devout, her faithful lovers, to perish? Oh, I should think a doubt so impious, so injurious to her, would be little less than blasphemy!

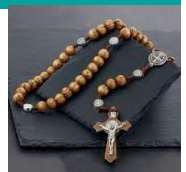

Para enfrentar la tierra pagana, los discípulos del Señor estamos llamados a fortalecernos, a reafirmarnos en la confianza en Dios que tiene el dominio sobre toda la historia. Ningún poder va a prevalecer sobre Aquel que lo ha creado todo. De esta manera el Evangelio de este Domingo (Mc 4, 35-41), muestra el dominio de Jesús sobre las aguas, y en ello se inauguran todos los signos que ratifican su Señorío.

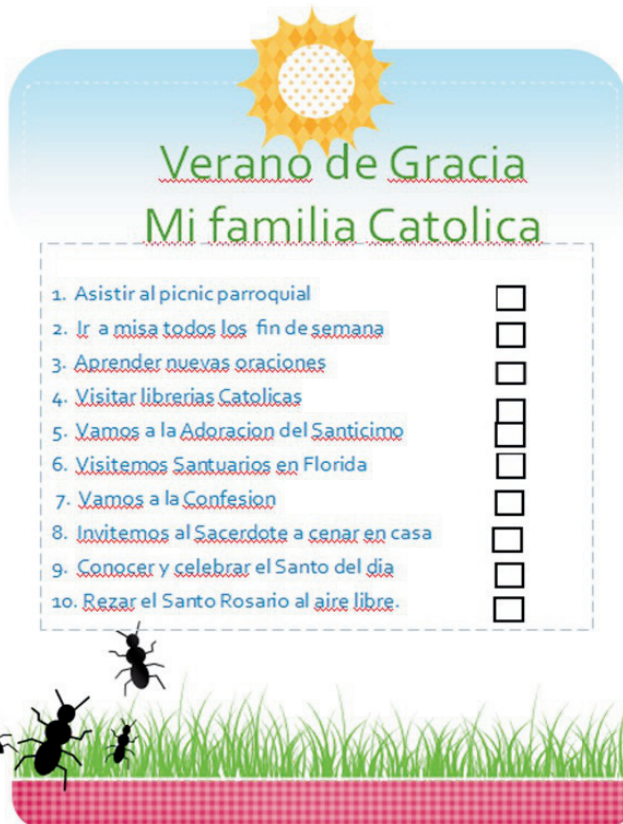

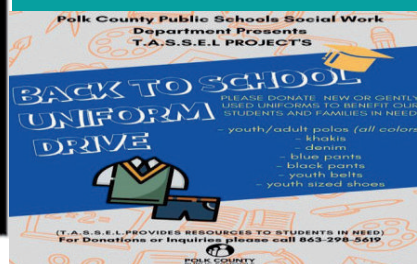

SAN SERAPION



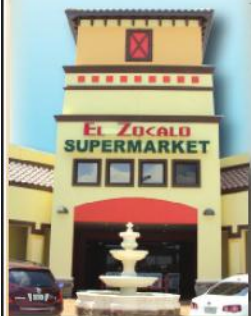
Serapion fue un monje egipcio que se convirtió en el director de la escuela catequética de Alejandría en Egipto. Después de un tiempo, un deseo de soledad se apoderó de él y se retiró al desierto, donde buscó la guía de San Antonio el Grande. Cuando Serapion fue nombrado obispo de Thmuis en el delta del Nilo, se encontró en el centro de la violenta herejía arriana. Serapion se puso del lado del gran baluarte de la ortodoxia en Oriente, San Atanasio, y fue exiliado sumariamente por el emperador.

Entre las obras escritas de Serapion se encuentran las cartas que dirigió a Atanasio en un intento de elaborar una respuesta a aquellos que negaban la divinidad del Espíritu Santo. También se atribuye a Serapion un sacramental temprano que contiene treinta oraciones para la Misa, la ordenación, el bautismo, el entierro y la bendición del aceite, el pan y el agua. Este sacramental contiene el primer uso registrado del Sanctus en la liturgia.

Serapion vivió de acuerdo con una regla simple que enseñó voluntariamente a los demás: "La mente se purifica mediante el conocimiento espiritual (o mediante la santa meditación y oración), las pasiones espirituales del alma mediante la caridad, y los apetitos irregulares mediante la abstinencia y la penitencia".
