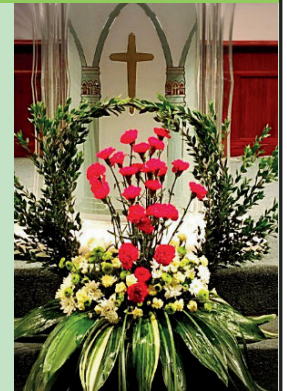

ARE WE READY FOR HEAVEN?



We are faithful people of God, and we have in mind that salvation is our great goal to reach in our spiritual life. We like to be in heaven! One day, a pastor, speaking of eternal life, asked his congregation whether they would love to go to heaven. The entire congregation answered with one voice: "YES." Then he asked: "Are you ready to go to heaven?" Half of the congregation answered: "YES." Then he asked those who were ready: "Would you like to go now?" No one said yes or no. Everyone remained in silence.

Have we ever wondered whether we are ready or doing enough to deserve eternal life? Maybe we know the theory or teachings of our Mother Catholic Church that, by believing in Jesus Christ and his resurrection, we will inherit eternal life; but how do we believe in Jesus Christ? Is it only a proclamation that we say but don't feel? Are we not completely convinced? Or do we still need to understand that to inherit the Kingdom of Heaven, we need to listen and be open to God's will and follow the teachings of our Savior?

Today, the Gospel basically talks about heaven and hell. It is very interesting how the Gospel describes what happens in these two states of souls. Heaven is defined as a state of rest, peace, and love. On the other hand, hell is a state of anguish and torment where it is possible to see what was lost and, once we are there, what we can never have. But for our Creator and God, Heaven is always open to everyone who tries to follow His commandments and makes our faith a way of life. Hell is the manifestation of our refusal to accept the love and mercy of God, with terrible consequences for our lives: suffering and desperation in this present life and the sad experience of not seeing God's face in the life everlasting.

My dear friends, we are children of God. The sacraments that we have received or we will receive (baptism, reconciliation, communion, confirmation, marriage, holy orders, or anointing of the sick) are visible signs that we would like to be in heaven, of our acceptance of the mercy and love of God, and how our faith in the resurrection of Christ made us heirs of life everlasting as well.

SAINT OF THE WEEK: ST. VINCENT DE PAUL



Saint of the Day for September 27:
(1580 - September 27, 1660)

The deathbed confession of a dying servant opened Vincent de Paul's eyes to the crying spiritual needs of the peasantry of France. This seems to have been a crucial moment in the life of the man from a small farm in Gascony, France, who had become a priest with little more ambition than to have a comfortable life.

The Countess de Gondi—whose servant he had helped—persuaded her husband to endow and support a group of able and zealous missionaries who would work among poor tenant farmers and country people. Vincent was too humble to accept leadership at first. But after working for some time in Paris among imprisoned galley slaves, he returned to be the leader of what is now known as the Congregation of the

Mission, or the Vincentians. With vows of poverty, chastity, obedience, and stability, these priests were to devote themselves entirely to the people in smaller towns and villages.

Later, Vincent established confraternities of charity for the spiritual and physical relief of the poor and sick of each parish. With the help of St. Louise de Marillac, from these came the Daughters of Charity, "whose convent is the sickroom, whose chapel is the parish church, whose cloister is the streets of the city." He organized the rich women of Paris to collect funds for his missionary projects, founded several hospitals, collected relief funds for the victims of war, and ransomed over 1,200 galley slaves from North Africa. He was zealous in conducting retreats for clergy at a time when there was great laxity, abuse, and ignorance among them. He was a pioneer in clerical training and was instrumental in establishing seminaries.

Most remarkably, Vincent was by temperament a very irascible person—even his friends admitted it. He said that except for the grace of God, he would have been "hard and repulsive, rough and cross." But he became a tender and affectionate man, very sensitive to the needs of others.

Pope Leo XIII made him the patron of all charitable societies. Outstanding among these is the Society of St. Vincent de Paul, founded in 1833 by his admirer Blessed Frédéric Ozanam.

Reflection:

The Church is for all God's children, rich and poor, peasants and scholars, the sophisticated and the simple. But obviously, the greatest concern of the Church must be for those who need the most help—those made helpless by sickness, poverty, ignorance, or cruelty. Vincent de Paul is a particularly appropriate patron for all Christians today when hunger has become starvation, and the high living of the rich stands in more and more glaring contrast to the physical and moral degradation in which many of God's children are forced to live.

The St. Vincent de Paul Society continuously assists the community with various programs that target those most vulnerable and in most need. SVDP delivers an array of resources and services to provide shelter, food, safety, material and financial assistance, and other forms of tangible help to those experiencing homelessness and poverty.

Somos pueblo fiel de Dios, y tenemos presente que la salvación es nuestra gran meta a alcanzar en nuestra vida espiritual. ¡Nos gusta estar en el cielo! Un día, un pastor, hablando de la vida eterna, preguntó a su congregación si les encantaría ir al cielo. Toda la congregación respondió a una sola voz: “SI”. Luego preguntó: “¿Estás listo para ir al cielo?”. La mitad de la congregación respondió: “SI”. Luego preguntó a los que estaban listos: “¿Te gustaría ir ahora?” Nadie dijo sí o no. Todos permanecieron en silencio.

¿Alguna vez nos hemos preguntado si estamos listos o haciendo lo suficiente para merecer la vida eterna? Tal vez conozcamos la teoría o enseñanzas de nuestra Madre Iglesia Católica de que, al creer en Jesucristo y su resurrección, heredaremos la vida eterna; pero ¿cómo creemos en Jesucristo? ¿Es sólo una proclamación que decimos pero no sentimos? ¿No estamos completamente convencidos? ¿O todavía necesitamos entender que para heredar el Reino de los Cielos, necesitamos escuchar y estar abiertos a la voluntad de Dios y seguir las enseñanzas de nuestro Salvador?

Hoy, el Evangelio habla básicamente del cielo y del infierno. Es muy interesante cómo describe el Evangelio lo que sucede en estos dos estados del alma. El cielo se define como un estado de descanso, paz y amor. Por otro lado, el infierno es un estado de angustia y tormento donde es posible ver lo que se perdió y, una vez que estamos allí, lo que nunca podremos tener. Pero para nuestro Creador y Dios, el Cielo siempre está abierto para todos los que intentan seguir Sus mandamientos y hacen de nuestra fe una forma de vida. El infierno es la manifestación de nuestra negativa a aceptar el amor y la misericordia de Dios, con terribles consecuencias para nuestra vida: sufrimiento y desesperación en esta vida presente y la triste experiencia de no ver el rostro de Dios en la vida eterna.

Mis queridos amigos, somos hijos de Dios. Los sacramentos que hemos recibido o recibiremos (bautismo, reconciliación, comunión, confirmación, matrimonio, orden sacerdotal o unción de los enfermos) son signos visibles de que nos gustaría estar en el cielo, de nuestra aceptación de la misericordia y del amor de Dios, y cómo nuestra fe en la resurrección de Cristo nos hizo herederos también de la vida eterna.
