## WHAT HAPPENS IN HEAVEN



The Sadducees were a religious group in Jesus' time that were well-educated and had the authority to teach and preach to people about some topics of spirituality. They were aligned with the Roman Empire and its authorities, which allowed them to keep their own religion and all their privileges. But they acted with hypocrisy because they were feeling subjugated by the Romans.

They pose a question about a childless woman whose husband dies, so she marries his brother as is the custom of the time. That brother also dies, and she marries the third brother. Eventually, she married and survived all seven brothers at the time of her death. The Sadducees want to know whose wife she will be in heaven. They wanted Jesus to provide a controversial answer as an ordinary teacher might since they did not recognize him as the Son of God.

The Sadducees were asking the wrong question for the wrong reason. They were not interested in the truth because they did not believe in the resurrection and eternal life.

Jesus knew their hearts and motivation. He spoke the truth. The question is not whose wife she would be in heaven but whether she would continue to live eternally with God. Jesus said you can't judge heaven like you judge the earth. Earthly life leads to death; heavenly life in eternity is different. There is no more death or pain, crying out, or concerns. The focus of those in heaven is God; all relationships are focused on him. Our fears while on earth no longer exist in heaven.

The same love of the Father will enable us to embrace all the trials and tribulations of life—even the moment of death. We know that nothing can separate us from the love of God. With this awareness and the hope of entering eternal life after death, we live each moment as if it is our last so that our life will be eternal in the presence of God.

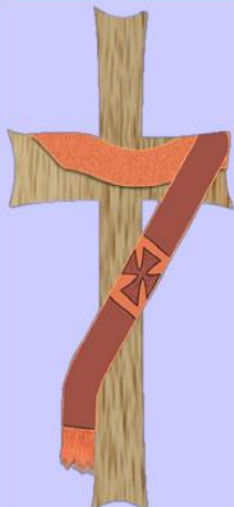

## SAINT OF THE WEEK: LEO THE GREAT



With an apparent strong conviction of the importance of the Bishop of Rome in the Church and of the Church as the ongoing sign of Christ's presence in the world, Leo the Great displayed endless dedication as pope. Elected in 440, he worked tirelessly as "Peter's successor," guiding his fellow bishops as "equals in the episcopacy and infirmities."

Leo is known as one of the best administrative popes of the ancient Church. His work branched into four main areas, indicative of his notion of the pope's total responsibility for the flock of Christ. He worked at length to control the heresies of Pelagianism—overemphasizing human freedom—Manichaeism—seeing everything material as evil—and others, placing demands on their followers to secure true Christian beliefs.

A second major area of his concern was doctrinal controversy in the Church in the East, to which he responded with a classic letter setting down the Church's teaching on the two natures of Christ. With strong faith, he also led the defense of Rome against barbarian attack, taking the role of peacemaker.

In these three areas, Leo's work has been highly regarded. His growth to sainthood has its basis in the spiritual depth with which he approached the pastoral care of his people, which was the fourth focus of his work. He is known for his spiritually profound sermons. Leo could reach his people's everyday needs and interests as an instrument of the call to holiness, well-versed in Scripture and ecclesiastical awareness. One of his sermons is used in the Office of Readings on Christmas.

Leo's true significance rests in his doctrinal insistence on the mysteries of Christ and the Church and the supernatural charisms of the spiritual life given to humanity in Christ and his Body, the Church. Thus Leo held firmly that everything he did and said as pope for the administration of the Church represented Christ, the head of the Mystical Body, and St. Peter, in whose place Leo acted.

**Reflection:** At a time when there is widespread criticism of Church structures, we also hear criticism that bishops and priests—indeed, all of us—are too preoccupied with the administration of temporal matters. Pope Leo is an example of a great administrator who used his talents in areas where spirit and structure are inseparably combined: doctrine, peace, and pastoral care. He avoided an "angelism" that tries to live without the Body and the "practicality" that deals only with externals.

As we are now in November, we have the Advent season right around the corner. The Tuesday Evening Religious Ed classes will take part in our parish's *Light For Christ* ceremony, which will be on Tuesday, December 6. Stay tuned for more information!

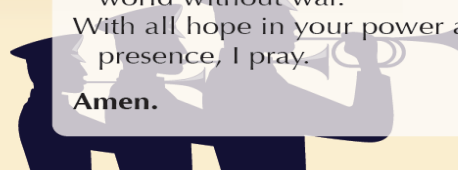
## REMEMBERING OUR VETERANS

Querían que Jesús diera una respuesta controvertida como lo haría un maestro ordinario, ya que no lo reconocían como el Hijo de Dios.

Los saduceos estaban haciendo la pregunta equivocada por la razón equivocada. No estaban interesados en la verdad porque no creían en la resurrección y la vida eterna.

Jesús conocía sus corazones y su motivación. Dijo la verdad. La cuestión no es de quién sería esposa en el cielo, sino si continuaría viviendo eternamente con Dios. Jesús dijo que no puedes juzgar el cielo como juzgas la tierra. La vida terrenal conduce a la muerte; la vida celestial en la eternidad es diferente. 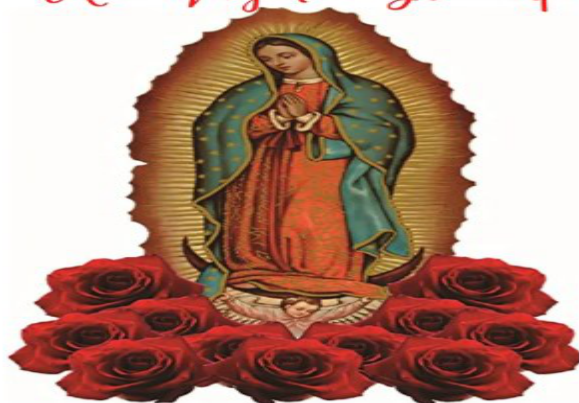
