



SALVATION THROUGH THE LOVE & LAW OF GOD



We continue with the meditation about the Sermon on the Mount, which Jesus, our Savior, began with a list of eight blessings we heard two Sundays ago. He concludes this first part of the Sermon by saying, "your reward will be great in heaven."

Last week, He called them the "salt of the earth" and "the light of the world" and said their mission on earth is to preserve life, heal wounds, add flavor to the lives of others, profess their faith in God openly, and engage in good works in their community for the glory of God.

Today, Jesus is clear about the law and is not here to abolish it or the prophets but to "carry them out." The word "law" is Torah in Hebrew; it refers to God's teaching, guidance, and instructions for living. It is often understood that the Torah is composed of the first five books of the Bible, but it also refers to the Scriptures in general. And the word "fulfill" is lekayem in Hebrew, which is mentioned in the Bible in different contexts. It means "to uphold," "to complete," or "to explain." Here, Jesus came to "fulfill the law," which means that Jesus came to interpret the Torah properly so that people could obey it as God really intended.

Jesus used phrases such as "You have heard... but I tell you" to point out that He was not contradicting the law but explaining it. Jesus wanted to bring them from the literal interpretation of the laws to the spirit of the laws. He wanted them to focus not only on external evil acts but also on the internal attitudes and motives that led to such acts. He often re-interpreted, explained, or added to the laws, sometimes in very radical ways. As a result, some of His teachings were very controversial. Luke writes that some people in his hometown of Nazareth became so angry with Him that they tried to throw Him off a cliff (Luke 4:28-30). Let's understand that what Jesus wishes for us is salvation, not to bother us or cause conflict. His message is strong but full of compassion, strict but created by God for us to live in peace and freedom that we can only find in Him.

OFFICE OF RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

The first week of registration for the 2023-2024 Academic year is now in the history books!

Thank you to all the parents, grandparents, and guardians who have registered children this past week. We would also like to thank you for making the effort to submit the required documents.

Registration for the upcoming week will take place on Thursday and Friday in the Fr. Carlos Building from 10:30 AM to 4:00 PM and on Saturday, February 18, from 1:00 PM to 2:30 PM. (This is a slight change from the published time.)

Since the Office of Religious Education will be closed on Tuesday, February 14, there is no scheduled registration session.

As a reminder, for children who have already received First Holy Communion, we are offering a continuing Religious Education home-study program for students in the 3^{rd} , 4^{th} , and 5^{th} grades. The cost for this program is \$35. (This is a reduction from the published fee.)

There will be a once-a-month gathering for one (I) hour in the Fr. Carlos Building for those participating in this program. These will take place on the first Sunday of each month in the Fr. Carlos Building at 11:00 AM, which includes the requirement of attending either the 10:00 AM Mass in English or the 12:00 PM Mass in Spanish.

WHAT IS THE OCIA RITE OF ELECTION?



On this First Sunday of Lent, Catholic bishops worldwide will welcome those sent by the parish to gather together with their godparents and sponsors in what is known as the Rite of Election. This Rite marks a key moment. For the catechumens, those over the age of seven seeking the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation, and First Holy Communion), this Rite signifies that they have been called by Christ and attests to the reality that only those mystically claimed by Christ will enter Heaven. St. John writes, "If anyone's name was not found written in the book of life, he was thrown into the lake of fire" (Rev 20:15). Throughout the RCIA process, catechumens

should have become increasingly involved with the parish community. The community, with godparents representing the parish, will wholeheartedly acclaim the participants' readiness. It is appropriate for the bishop to recognize them because he is the sign of unity of the particular Church, and it is the parish community's responsibility to bring those in RCIA into the fullness of the life of the Church. The godparents give public testimony about the catechumens. The godparents' role is very significant; they represent the community and are asked during this Rite to make serious statements about the catechumens. The decision of an RCIA participant to go through this Rite means that the judgment and decision-making (of both the catechumen and the parish) about whether to enter the Catholic Church has ended. From this point forward, they are no longer catechumens but are called the "elect." They have been chosen to enter into the final period of preparation for initiation and called by the bishop, their shepherd, to the holy mysteries to be celebrated at Easter.



SAINT OF THE WEEK: THE SEVEN FOUNDERS OF THE SERVITE ORDER



Can you imagine seven prominent men of Boston or Denver banding together, leaving their homes and professions, and going into solitude for a life directly given to God? That is what happened in the cultured and prosperous city of Florence in the middle of the 13th century. The city was torn by political strife and the heresy of the Cathari, who believed that physical reality was inherently evil. Morals were low, and religion seemed meaningless.

In 1240, seven noblemen of Florence mutually decided to withdraw from the city to a solitary place for prayer and direct service to God. Their initial difficulty was providing for their dependents since two were still married and two were widowers.

Their aim was to lead a life of penance and prayer, but they soon found themselves disturbed by constant visitors from Florence. They next withdrew to the deserted slopes of Monte Senario.

In 1244, under the direction of St. Peter of Verona, O.P., this small group adopted a religious habit similar to the Dominican habit, choosing to live under the Rule of St. Augustine and adopting the name of the Servants of Mary. The new Order took a form more like that of the mendicant friars than the older monastic Orders.

Members of the community came to the United States from Austria in 1852 and settled in New York and later in Philadelphia. The two American provinces developed from the foundation made by Fr. Austin Morini in 1870 in Wisconsin.

Community members combined monastic life and active ministry. In the monastery, they led a life of prayer, work, and silence; in the active apostolate, they engaged in parochial work, teaching, preaching, and other ministerial activities.

Reflection: The time in which the seven Servite founders lived is very easily comparable to the situation we find ourselves in today. It is "the best of times and the worst of times," as Dickens once wrote. Perhaps many feel called to a countercultural life, even in religion. All of us are faced in a new and urgent way with the challenge to make our lives decisively centered in Christ.



SALVACIÓN A TRAVÉS DEL AMOR Y LA LEY DE DIOS



Continuamos con la meditación sobre el Sermón de la Montaña, que Jesús, nuestro Salvador, comenzó con una lista de ocho bendiciones que escuchamos hace dos domingos. Concluye esta primera parte del sermón diciendo: "tu recompensa será grande en el cielo".

La semana pasada, los llamó "la sal de la tierra" y "la luz del mundo" y dijo que su misión en la tierra es preservar la vida, sanar las heridas, dar sabor a la vida de los demás, profesar abiertamente su fe en Dios, y participar en buenas obras en su comunidad para la gloria de

Hoy, Jesús tiene clara la ley y no está para abolirla ni abolir los profetas sino para "cumplirlos". La palabra "ley" es Torá en hebreo; se refiere a la enseñanza, la guía y las

instrucciones de Dios para vivir. A menudo se entiende que la Torá está compuesta por los primeros cinco libros de la Biblia, pero también se refiere a las Escrituras en general. Y la palabra "cumplir" es lekayem en hebreo, que se menciona en la Biblia en diferentes contextos. Significa "mantener", "completar" o "explicar". Aquí, Jesús vino a "cumplir la ley", lo que significa que Jesús vino a interpretar la Torá correctamente para que la gente pudiera obedecerla como Dios realmente quería.

Jesús usó frases como "Habéis oído... pero yo os digo" para señalar que Él no estaba contradiciendo la ley sino explicándola. Jesús quería llevarlos de la interpretación literal de las leyes al espíritu de las leyes. Quería que se enfocaran no solo en los actos malignos externos sino también en las actitudes internas y los motivos que llevaron a tales actos. A menudo reinterpretaba, explicaba o añadía leyes, a veces de forma muy radical. Como resultado, algunas de Sus enseñanzas fueron muy controvertidas. Lucas escribe que algunas personas en su ciudad natal de Nazaret se enojaron tanto con Él que trataron de tirarlo por un precipicio (Lucas 4:28-30). Entendamos que lo que Jesús desea para nosotros es la salvación, no molestarnos ni causarnos conflicto. Su mensaje es fuerte pero lleno de compasión, estricto pero creado por Dios para que vivamos en la paz y la libertad que solo podemos encontrar en Él.


